#### **MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION**

- A plaque presentation was done by Councilwoman Williams to the family of the Late Isaac Douglas Lewis acknowledging his life and achievements.
- Plaques presentation was done by Councilman Corbitt to two Orange High School students. One Xivandell Emmanuel for being the second place winner and the other to Danelle Welcome for being

the first place winner in the Local Talk Community Foundation Public Speaking Scholarship Contest.

- A presentation was made by Superintendant Ronald Lee about the current state of Orange. He
  thanked the Council for recognizing the talent Orange has, also he addressed the grade hacking
  situation that occurred at Orange High School and he acknowledges the achievements and
  accomplishments of the schools in the district.
- A presentation was made by Myra Burks-Davis-President-MBD Strategies, LLC where she stated that she will work with the council to expose the positivity that is going on in Orange and that there is a flood of information coming in but no structure to get it out. She also stated how we create an infrastructure that will allow the information that the council wants to get out to the constituents. The solution she has is technology driven; that will have the sense of a newsletter website.

- Councilwoman Jones-Bell complemented Superintendant Ronald Lee on a job well done.
