### Ronald Lee-Superintendent of Orange Board of Ed.

Mr. Lee was at the meeting to discuss the Board of Education's impact on the City's budget. The FSRA funding formula is not being used by Gov. Christy so the Board of Education has asked for a 2%

increase by the City for the past few years. The School system had been underfunded for 4 years because the FSRA Fund had not been given to the schools. State Aid this year was \$700,000.00 which meant that the schools were underfunded by 12 million dollars. Gov. Christy proposed a fund that would provide each student \$6,500. Mr. Lee stated the problems with that proposal. Mr. Lee listened to kind comments from the Council and answered questions.

The City Clerk, Joyce Lanier, presented certificates of appreciation to Council President April Gaunt-Butler and Councilman Elroy Corbitt for their long and faithful service to the City.
