NEW BUSINESS

A. Certificate of Appropriateness Application - 301 Main Street, Orange, N.J. (Windows and front facade) Carry Over

Secretary Lanier advised Applicant for 307-309 Main Street will be heard first since applicants are present at the meeting.

B. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 307-309 Main Street, Orange, N.J. (Front and side walls, stucco on both sides of building) (Moved from the March Meeting at the request of Applicant) – Carry Over

The owner of the property Jerald Goldfine appeared. He advised that in October 2017, he was contacted by the Building Department and met an inspector from the City who asked if they would do modifications to their building to improve it for downtown. A permit was obtained for the sidewalk bridge. Thereafter, they were not able to obtain anymore permits for work and were advised that they had to come before the Historic Preservation Committee.

The applicant advised that they would like to replace and repair the front façade, patch and repair the existing stucco on the entire left side and rear of the building, as well as, paint the fire escape. In addition, he advised that the aluminum siding in the front had already been removed.

The HPC granted a limited certificate of appropriateness to the applicant to power wash the building, repoint the brick, mortar and repair any cracks that are located in the front of the building. This will give the applicant a clear picture of what repairs are necessary to bring the building back to its original appearance and keep the character of a historic look. In addition, the applicant is to replace existing brick with like kind and appropriate brick veneer.

Lastly, the HPC requires the applicant to come back before the Commission with additional plans for window repair.
