NEW BUSINESS

A. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 145-147 Main Street, Orange, N.J. (McDonalds) - Carry Over (New Plans submitted)

Joe Sparone from Dynamic Engineering and Freddie Walsh appeared. This application was heard before the Commission back in February 21, 2018. The Commission asked the applicant to come back with different renditions.

New plans with a redesigned building incorporating the recommendations of the Commission was distributed. Several Commissioners expressed concern about the drive thru circulation and exiting the drive thru. Mr. Sparone advised that a traffic study was conducted. The entrance would be on Main Street and exiting would be on either Park Street or Main Street. Mr. Sparone advised that a side-by-side drive thru should alleviate traffic coming into the McDonalds.

Commissioner Simmons inquired who will be up keeping the landscape. Mr. Sparone advised that the owner/operator will be responsible. Mr. Sparone informed the Commission that they worked with the City Planner to incorporate what other businesses in the area were doing.

B. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 164 Main Street, Orange, N.J. (Demolition of the Building - Orange Commons Urban Renewal)

Rich Dunn with Paramount Assets appeared and advised that they are the redeveloper for 164 Main Street – the Orange Commons location. A redevelopment plan is in the works for the location with many possibilities. They have meet with the public to see how to best use the 1.5-acre property, which was built in 1980. They would like approval to start the process of a redevelopment and demolish the building. Photos of the current property site was distributed to the Commission. Goal is to start the process of redevelopment. A possibility is a Wawa full service. Other possibilities include reconstructing building for national retail use and a regional laundromat. Commercial plan may demolish ½ of the building, but Wawa would use the whole property. They will be going before the Planning Board with the Wawa application.

C. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 179 Tremont Avenue, Orange, N.J. (Demolition of the Building – Fire Damage)

Authority Ugbenin appeared and advised that the building was badly damaged by fire. They would like to rebuild the building and is inquiring about what materials, colors and roof must be used.

Commissioner Simmons confirmed house was gutted by fire. Owner would like to rebuild with like-kind materials and advised building is unsalvageable. Commissioner Meyer inquired as to what inspection was done to confirm the building is unsalvageable. Commissioner Simmons recommended that the owner hire a certified structural engineer and then come back to the Commission.

No vote was taken on this application.

D. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 301 Main Street, Orange, NJ (Carry Over Windows and front façade) – Carry Over

Mr. Milton Sonnenberg, Senior Property and Risk Manager for ACHS Management Corp., and Mr. Jack Cohen, appeared. They testified that existing windows cannot be repaired. The Commission's concern is that windows be as close to the windows being replaced. Commissioner Simmons expressed concern about losing the lighting. Mr. Stelios Banagos, a contractor, also appeared and described in detail the improvements they proposed.

Commissioner Simmons requested them to come back or submit design for windows for consideration and approval.

Motion to approve exterior renovations, repairs, and repointing, except for the windows. The applicant must return or submit design for windows for approval.
