J. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 348 Main Street – Library Mural

Carry over from last meeting - Unconditional Approval

The Secretary announced that this application was a carry-over from the meeting on ----, and the new application was made available. A representative from the library was present to answer any questions from the Commission. Ms. Julie Martini who works for Valley Arts was prepared to answer questions. Commissioner Bruce Meyer inquired why the Commission could not have a simple diagram for what the project is and that he was unaware that this was a petition only for the mural. Ms. Martini stated that this petition only covers the Mural and she doesn't know the plans for the rest of the area. She believes they are thinking of making plans to make the outside area a relaxing environment for children to play and adults to read and enjoy the outdoors. Commissioner Brandon Matthews inquired about the photo in the packet with the square drawn on it, and whether or not that was the location that she was speaking of. Ms. Martini explained. that was the location, but was not sure if the square represented the exact approximation. There is a rendering of the Mural in the package and they will try to keep this particular aspect ratio, this width and length. They will have someone come measure and use grommets to attach the mural as it will not be painted on the wall. The firm, Custom Sign Source will manufacture the sign out of the most appropriate material, which is probably a vinyl, then use grommets and do the installations. The mural will not come down to the ground, it will be printed and can be replaced. Commissioner Brandon Matthews asked if the vinyl could easily be vandalized. Ms. Martini explained that a part of the installation will replace lighting which they are hoping will deter vandalism. Commissioner Wells stated other murals have not been vandalized, but Commissioner Leight stated the mural on Valley was badly vandalized. Commissioner Simmons requested that the overall project be presented at one time to make a better judgement. The goal is not to become just another mural on the building and that it can be reproduced. The Commission would like to see the full master plan. Commissioner Dowd thought we were really focusing on the mural. Commissioner Velez inquired about the lighting at night and Ms. Martini replied that there will be light at night and it would be more than one installed. On the motion. Attorney Bauer directed Ms. Martini to Secretary, Joyce Lanier's office (The City Clerk's Office) to acquire the Principals of Preservation, and Design Guidelines after three days. The Commission offered help to make the project successful.

Domenick Trezza made application on April 25, 2017 on behalf of Keystone Properties, LLC to install replacement windows which are currently a mixture of vinyl and metal. Wood windows and all the casings are vinyl replacing with vinyl. Andrew Davlouros (representative) stated this

is a single family home and he will replace the existing window with no change to the opening size just the style. He provided a packet with photos to show the five different styles of windows that exist. Pointing to the East Elevation where the prior owner had pieced together two windows on the Juliet Balcony to fill in the door opening and they want the door back in place. Commissioner Simmons asked if the overall goal was to restore the house and that he could get him the original plans (exterior and interior) if he wanted. Mr. Davlouros confirmed he was restoring, he would like the plans, and they have already begun restoring things that didn't require permission from this board. Commissioner Simmons said he should consider wood clad or venere composite. Mr. Davlouros stated the porch will remain the same. Secretary, Joyce Lanier advised Mr. Davlouros to go to the City Clerk's office in three days for information requested.

PENDING BUSINESS/FURTHER DISCUSSION

Secretary, Joyce Lanier addressed the Zoning Officer, Richard Wolff concerning the gentleman who came in front of the Commission at the April 19, 207 meeting in regards to the corner property of 664 Valley Street. Secretary, Joyce Lanier reminded the board that she had sent each of them an e-mail in regards to the exterior of this property and the deck. At the time this came before the Commission, no one was aware that this was a corner property. He wants to open the back of the deck and Attorney Bauer's thoughts were that he didn't need to come before the Commission again to get approval for this. Mr. Wolff has not seen the plans and would like to see them before making comments.

Attorney Bauer stated that the Board of Education should be discussed. The Secretary stated that at the Facilities meeting, the State said they would forward their portion of the plans to her. The Board offered a second version, and all agreed it was better. They will not demolish the house but somewhat fence it in, board it up, and put parking spaces around it. It was stated that the Commission should wait until they receive the entire plan to make any decision because the State had agreed to update their drawings and include the Architects plans for it across the street all in to one Master plan. The State has its own plans based solely on the buildings and the Architect for the Board of Education has a completely separate plan which includes parking on site, across the street and around the housing there. Attorney

Bauer, wants to know the boundaries of the site plans. Secretary, Joyce Lanier stated that, her understanding from the meeting was, the District Architect was responsible for the parking lot, and the State has nothing to do with it. The Commission have the District's plan but do not have the State's plan for across the street. Attorney Bauer suggested the Commission write a letter to memorialize their understanding of what composite plan will be drawn up and provided because there has been a lot of misunderstandings. She wants a draft from someone who attended the meeting and she will complete the letter. Commissioner Troy Simmons inquired if anyone at the meeting knew if there were discussions about using 286 Clarendon for Administrative Offices because the Commission agreed that boarding up the house was not a good plan. Commissioner Troy Simmons affirmed a letter will be drafted and then a meeting needs to be arranged to discuss the Clarendon property.

Secretary, Joyce Lanier stated the guidelines does not require one to replace anything that is not already there with any other material which already exists, this is in regards to 237 Ivy Court. Commissioner Troy Simmons stated that we need not rush to decisions. Attorney Janine Bauer reiterated the specifics of the case. She also spoke to the Commissioners on how to speak up about a case before the motion as in Robert's Rules. Secretary, Joyce Lanier gave a few pointers from Robert's Rules so that all Commissioners were on the same page and understand the correct voting process. Attorney Janine Bauer will create a one pager on Robert's Rules and Guidelines via e-mail for the next meeting. Secretary Joyce Lanier stated there was an ordinance on first reading that the Business Administrator, Chris Hartwyk withdrew because he wanted to speak to the Nishuane Group further to get more details and clarification, and the ordinance is not moving. Shawna Ebanks of Nishuane Group was unaware of the issues that the Business Administrator had and she doesn't believe there will be changes made to the Master Plan. Commissioner Troy Simmons asked Shawna Eubanks about redevelopment and how the Historic Preservation can be included in these processes as they could add to redevelopment.

Attorney Janine Bauer stated she will have the Resolution for the Education Committee ready for the next meeting. She wanted to get the volunteers which Commissioner Karen Wells, Troy Simmons, and Keith Carrol all volunteered with Commissioner Abdiel Velez and Commissioner Brandon Matthews as alternates.
