# Department Function

The Department of Community Services performs functions in accordance with article XII 4-49 of the municipal code.

- Administer public health programs as environmental sanitation, maternal and child health, communicable disease control and vital statistics registration.
- Administer social programs for the needy as public assistance, medical care and hospitalization, dental clinics and fresh air camps.
- Administer recreation programs for persons of all ages and varied interests and abilities, including the physically handicapped in all areas of the city.

The Department of Community Services works to promote the well-being of children, young adults and the senior community.

We enhance the quality of life by promoting good physical and mental health, preventing illness and injury, protecting the environment, and providing recreational services to residents of all ages.

We work to build stronger families and communities, a collaboration of public events and festivals, and information exchange.

## Animal Control

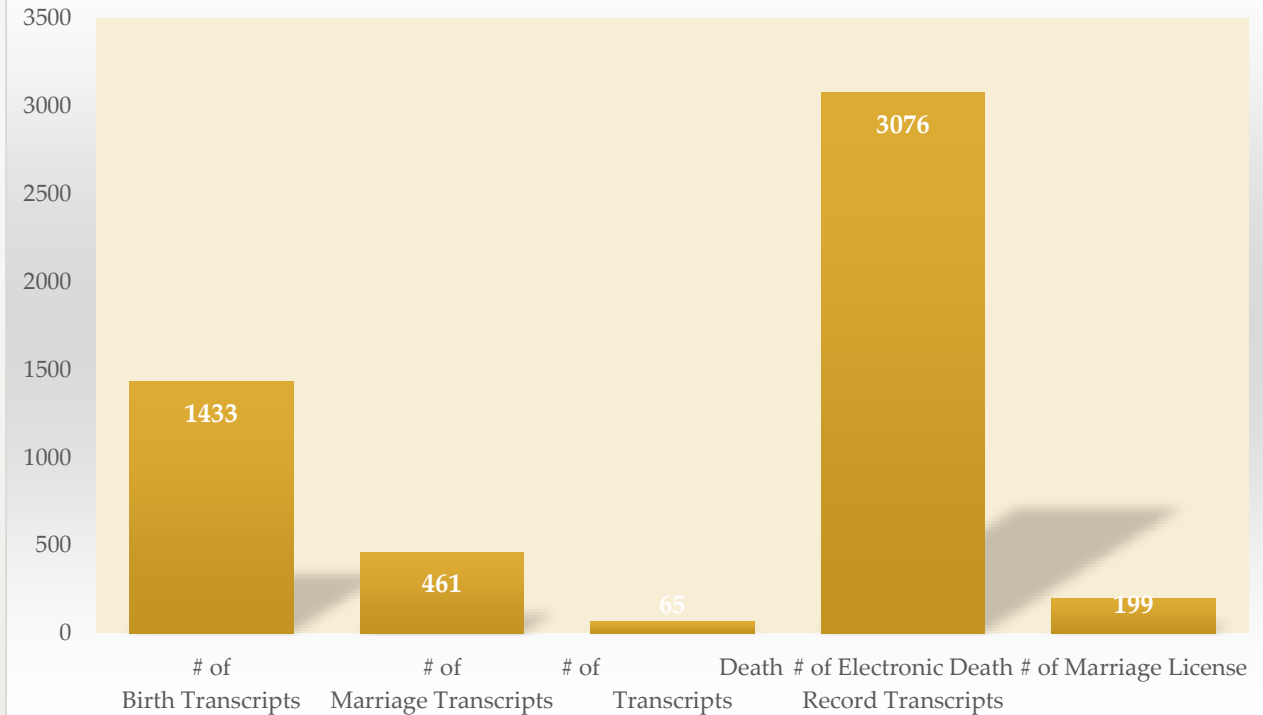
- Daily city wide animal canvass patrol .

- Educate the public about animal welfare, and animal control laws and regulations.
- Examine animals for injuries or malnutrition, and arrange for any necessary medical treatment.
