Notice is hereby given that sealed "Request for Qualifications" (under the provision of Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40:A-11-4.1 et seq.) will be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 14, 2019 by the Director of Public Works & Engineering on the 3rd Floor, Public Works Department, City Hall, 29 North Day Street, Orange, New Jersey 07050.

The City of Orange Township is soliciting qualifications for the selection of an engineering firm to provide Municipal Engineering services to the City.

Instructions for the preparation and submission of the qualifications may be obtained at the Office of Public Works and Engineering, 29 North Day Street, Orange, New Jersey 07050 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday commencing on the date of this notice.

An original and two (2) copies of the qualifications and all supporting documents shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked to indicate the name and address of the proposal, the subject of the proposal and date of proposal opening. Responses may either be mailed or delivered in person. Mailed responses will be held and opened at the above specified time and date. Responses received by the Department of Public Works after the time for opening proposals will be returned unopened.

The City of Orange Township is not responsible for late delivery by the United States Postal Service or any other carrier.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of NJSA 10:5-31 et seq. and Affirmative Action requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127 (NJAC 17:27 et seq.) and Local Unit Pay-To-Play Law (P.L. 2004, c19, as amended by P.L. 2005, c51).

These proposals are being solicited through a Fair and Open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

Award for the contract will be made to the firm whose "Request for Qualifications" is most advantageous to the City of Orange Township, cost and other factors considered.

The City reserves the right to accept the proposal it deems most advantageous or to reject all proposals.
