TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 26 ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP". (Sponsored by Council Member Tency A. Eason).

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Police Officers Conduct off duty work; and

WHEREAS, a determination has been made that the City of Orange Township Code needs to be amended to revise the conditions for payment of cancellation fees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 26 of the Code is amended as follows:

SECTION 1.

§ 26-6.1. Contracted off-duty employment of police officers. [Added 7-2-02 by Ord. No. 10-2002; amended 8-15-2015 by Ord. No. 40-2015.]

D. Rates of compensation; administrative fee; payment for services.

(1) Rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty law enforcement officers shall be established by ordinance adopted from time to time by the governing body. The current rate of compensation shall be as follows:

Work Type	Work Rate	Officers Pay Rate	Administrative Fee
Construction/ traffic Control	\$85.00 per hour	\$75.00	\$10.00
School/bar/tavern security	\$55.00 per hour	\$45.00	\$10.00
Special Events	\$32.00 per hour	\$27.00	\$5.00

(2) Cancellation. In the event that the person or entity requesting the off-duty law enforcement officers fails to contact the City of Orange at least four hours prior to the scheduled start time to cancel the job, or the officer works less than four hours and the job is completed, the officer is entitled to be paid for the minimum of four hours.

~~(2)~~ (3) An additional fee will be established by ordinance adopted from time to time by the governing body to cover administrative costs, overhead, equipment utilization and out-of-pocket expenses for the City of Orange Township.

~~(3)~~ (4) All other Ordinances or portions of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency only.

~~(4)~~ (5) If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or inoperative, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Severability of Ordinance Provisions

Each section of this ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity of constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

SECTION 3. Conflict of Other Ordinance Provisions

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

That this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided
