WHEREAS, the Director of Planning has further reviewed the required documents submitted with the fee schedule, and find them to be in compliance with Federal, State and Local laws; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering firm of CP Professional Services has completed and submitted a Business Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City in the previous one (1) year, except that the year 2005 is an exception to this requirement as the one year immediately preceding the effective date of the law, as that term is defined below, and that the contract will prohibit CP Professional Services from making any reportable contributions throughout the term of the contract; and
