**NOW, THEREFORE,** the City engages the services of the Consultant", and in consideration of the recitals and the mutual promises contained in this agreement, the parties agree as follows:

#### **AMENDMENT**

15. This agreement only be amended or modified by writing executed by both parties to this agreement.

#### **LEGAL CONSTRUCTION**

16. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not effect any other provision of this agreement and this agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in it.

**REMINGTON & VERNICK ENGINEERS (RVE)** is pleased to submit this proposal to perform an assessment of asbestos containing materials (ACMs) and presumed asbestos containing materials (PACM) including the collection and laboratory analysis of bulk samples within the accessible interior areas of the City Hall building located at 29 N. Day Street.

On January 24, 2020 the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDLWD), Office of Public Employees' Occupational Safety and Health (OPEOSH) issued a *Notice of Order to Comply* (NOC) (Inspection # 1440703).

Please note, this proposal is being submitted to specifically address Citation 1, Item 1 of the NOC which states: "records were not available for review concerning the presence, location, and quantity of asbestos containing materials (ACM) and presumed asbestos containing materials (PACM) in the building". RVE will submit additional recommendations to satisfy the remaining items of the NOC under a separate letter.

Accordingly, RVE will provide the following scope of services to satisfy the requirements of Citation 1, Item 1:

- Inspect, identify, sample, qualify, and quantify ACM's and PACM's with in the interior offices, common areas, storage closets, and maintenance areas.
- All samples will be submitted to and tested by the International Asbestos Testing Laboratories (IATL), and American Industrial Hygiene Association (AIHA) accredited laboratory. RVE assumes that no more than 100 samples will be collected.
- Prepare a summary report of findings including sample analytical results. The summary report will include
  Site Drawings depicting sample locations and locations of confirmed ACM in all surveyed areas. Site
  Drawings used for the summary report shall show general outline of the subject building/structure footprint
  and sample locations only.

RVE estimates that no more than two (2) site visits by our certified, two-person sampling team will be required for the proper inspection and sampling of ACM's & PACM's identified during our survey within the building. RVE shall perform the ACM and PACM survey, including all bulk sampling, during non-business hours, such as on a weekday after the building is closed for business and closed to the public.
