A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 33-2020 TITLED "AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP AND ABC EMERGENCY RENTAL FOR THE PROVISION OF LEASING AN AMERICAN LAFRANCE LADDER, QUINT SQUIRT COMMENCING JANUARY 10, 2020 TO JUNE 25, 2020 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$63,143.00." TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT UNTIL AUGUST 31, 2020 FOR AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00 MAKING A NEW AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED OF 78,143.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department has a perpetual need to maintain emergency response in the form of fire apparatus responding to a fire, or first responder call that is available to it residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township has a responsibility to maintain the quality of its emergency response services even in the event that an apparatus will be out of service for an extended period of time due to repairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township is authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 to enter into a contract on an emergency basis when the emergency affects public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services; and

WHEREAS, the qualified purchasing agent of the City of Orange Township has been notified of this emergency in writing, and he is in agreeance that an emergency exists; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020 Governor Murphy, through Executive Order No. 103, issued a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has delayed the delivery of our new Ferrara Pumper Engine; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township seeks to extend the lease an American LaFrance Ladder, Quint Squir ("Pumper") from ABC Emergency Rental until August 31, 2020 for an additional \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, the availability of funds is provided through an emergency appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized the extension of the contract with ABC Emergency Rental for an American LaFrance Ladder, Quint Squir until August 31, 2020 for an additional amount of \$15,000.00 making a new amount not to exceed of 78,143.00.






WHEREAS, ABC Emergency Rental, and the City of Orange Township have agreed to the terms of a Master Agreement providing the Township with the Pumper.

Subject: Proprietary Vendor Affirmation for ABC Emergency Leasing

I, Kenneth M. Douglas, Fire Director for the City of Orange Township, in Essex, New Jersey, affirm that:

On December 7, 2019, Engine 2 was involved in an accident that caused severe mechanical and frame damage resulting in it being inoperable to respond to fires and emergencies which negatively affects emergency response and community safety.

For this reason, an extensive search was conducted through the internet, public safety partners and neighboring cities in an effort to rent or lease a fire apparatus for firefighting duties.

As a result of this search, it has been concluded that ABC Emergency Leasing is the only entity in the North East region offering the use of front-line fire apparatus for the use of firefighting.

At this time, there is no foreseeable time frame that Engine 2 will be repaired.
