A. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – 307 Main Street, Orange, N.J. (removing existing awning and signs and installing a new signs)

He advised that the building has two occupying tenants and they are proposing to remove the awning and signage to uncover what is below. Elisa Avilla a representing for the applicant appeared and advised the commissioners they would like to install a stone retaining wall four to six feet high on the right side of the property extending to and around the rear of the property with the option of continuing it on the left side. They will be using stone manufactured by Cambridge. In addition, they are requesting permission to construct and install pavers on both driveway surfaces. Samples of stone and pavers were provided.

Motion to approve application to install a stone retaining wall on the right, back and left side of the property with stone manufactured by Cambridge using colors complementary to the house. In addition, approval of installation of pavers on the driveway which allows pervious percolation no more than 30% lot coverage of the property. VIII. OTHER BUSINESS

• 595 Lincoln Avenue Redevelopment

Commissioner Dowd informed the Commission that she attended the meeting for the redevelopment of the old police station and their initial plans are to rehab the station, add an addition, and a parking garage on the back. The redevelopment would include one and two bedroom units and lofts. Unfortunately, allocating one (1) parking spot for each. The developer

advised the only way to accommodate more parking is to demolish the building and to allow for a better ratio of parking. Residents present were in favor of not having more parking on the street. Commissioner Dowd advised that the BA mentioned that the developer did not need to come before the HPC for any demolition plans. After discussion with both BA and developer, the developer agreed to come before the HPC with new plans.

Commissioner Morrell brought up the issue of ownership of the building between Orange Board of Education and the Administration since they cannot locate original agreement that allowed the Police Department to function from that building. The site is the original Tremont School integrated in Orange.

248 Roberts Road

Zoning Officer Richard Wolfe brought to the attention to the Commission that the owner of 248 Roberts Road has done work on the property without permits. The Construction Official has stopped their work and the Zoning Officer has sent them a letter advising that they must come before the HPC. They have replaced the windows, siding, and stone work on the driveway and maybe the porch. The interior has also been stripped without any permits.

Commissioner Dowd advised that she reached out several times to Mr. James but never received a returned call. She was able to have a conversation with Administrator Mr. Iodelli and advised him that the property is a mess, there is garbage, broken bottles, cut down wood chips, a toilet from the property. Furthermore, she told Mr. James that if there is no response she will get in contact with code enforcement. Mr. Iodelli advised that the property needs to be cleaned up and stated that they found funding for the parking lot and it will be completed by August 2019. A letter from the HPC Attorney will be sent to Code Enforcement.
