

# General Election

## Tuesday, November 3, 2020

Amid the ongoing coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Governor Murphy signed Executive Order No. 177 on August 14, 2020 to create a modified vote-by-mail (VBM) election for the November 3<sup>rd</sup> General Election. The County Clerk will send VBM ballots with pre-paid postage to all active registered voters.

Ballots can be returned to via a secure drop box, the United States Postal Service (USPS), to the County Board of Elections or an Orange polling location on Election Day with valid identification.

### Deadlines

- Tuesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> - to register to vote or change your address. Orange City Hall will be open until 9:00 PM 29 North Day Street
- **REGISTRATER TO VOTE ON LINE – FASTEST WAY** – <http://voter.svrs.nj.gov/register>
- Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> by 3:00 p.m.- to request an absent ballot
- Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> by 8:00 p.m. - to deliver an in-person absentee ballot

Ballots returned through USPS with a postmark on or before November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be counted as a valid ballot by the County Clerk, if received by 8:00 p.m. on November 10<sup>th</sup>.

Ballots without a postmark that are received by the County Boards of Elections on or before November 5<sup>th</sup> by 8:00 p.m. shall be considered valid.
