ORDINANCES-SECOND READING/PUBLIC HEARING

- 47-2020 Amending and supplementing Chapter 88 "Fees" Department of Planning and Development and Zoning Information Request Fees – CR asked if this fee is comparable as surrounding towns. CH confirmed that it is. Move forward
- 48-2020 **Repealing Chapter 210, "Development Regulations"** CH confirmed that this is the new Zoning ordinance; necessary to implement the Master Rezoning Plan. Move forward

55-2020 Amending Chapter 200 "Vehicles and Traffic" Residential Permit (Berryman Place) – TE confirmed the parking crisis in Orange. Move forward.

- *447-2020 Ratifying and authorizing the extension of the agreement for traffic signal maintenance and repairs with Jen Electric, Inc. CR asked if Jen Electric was in the Morris County Co-Op? CH confirmed that they were but did not renew so they are not in the Co-Op anymore. Move forward
- *448-2020 Authorizing settlement in the matter of Kenneth Duff and Sandy Duff V. City of Orange Move forward
- 449-2020 (WO) **Temporarily freezing discretionary salary increases for all positions.** CR asked for clarification on discretionary. CH explained that this means anything not covered

by a collective bargaining agreement. Discussion on language of resolution either stating "whichever occurs first" vs. "whichever is longer". CH confirmed that the draft sent used the "whichever is longer" language, which is not the resolution in front of Council. TE advised that language can also be amended. AM suggested for the Finance Committee to recommend the amendment to the language and will replace on agenda when walk-on introduced in Regular session. Move forward
