MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

Vincent DeFillippo, City of Orange's Health Officer discussed the following update regarding COVID-19:

- As of January 25th, 35,000 Essex County residents have been vaccinated.
- City is working on arrangements to bring the vaccine to seniors at senior buildings and home bound residents.

- Seniors can get assistance to register for a vaccine with Senior Services at (973) 592-8147.
- The following hospitals now have the vaccine: St. Barnabas, East Orange General, Clara Mass and Newark Beth Israel.
- Visited the two new COVID-19 vaccination centers at Donald M. Payne, Sr. School of Technology and Essex County College.
- Essex County COVID call center numbers are (973) 877-8456 and (855) 568-0545.
- As of January 19th, 100 Orange residents have been vaccinated.
- Arrangements are being made to get vaccines to small churches in Orange.

Dr. Gerald Fitzhugh, II, Orange Public Schools Superintendent provided the following update:

- The schools are now in Phase II and the students are scheduled to return physically to school on March 1, 2021.
- Encouraged residents to get the Orange Public School's app to get up-to-date information as it related to the schools.
