TITLE: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 APPROPRIATING \$8,000,000 FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF WATER MAIN ON THOMAS BOULEVARD TO BE FULLY FUNDED BY A BOND ORDINANCE OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to the funding of the replacement of water main on Thomas Boulevard between Washington and Hayward Streets, and no adequate provision was made in the 2021 Temporary Budget for the unforeseen aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an Emergency Temporary Appropriation for the purpose above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary appropriations adopted in Calendar Year 2021 including this appropriation to be created by this resolution totals \$8,625,000 for the Current Fund and \$8,000,000 for the Water/Sewer Utility Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Orange Township in the County of Essex (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 that:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made for:

Water/Sewer Utility Fund

Capital Improvements – Replacement of Water Main \$8,000,000

2. That said emergency temporary appropriation shall be provided for in full by a bond ordinance of the City prior to the adoption of the 2021 budget.
3. That funds for the appropriation shall be provided from surplus funds on hand.
4. That the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the expenditures to be financed through this resolution are related to the aforementioned emergency.
5. That two (2) certified copies of this Resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
