WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township is always making efforts to improve the quality of life for its residents and commuters by making the town safer; and

WHEREAS, there is an underpass near Orange Train Station that is perilous due to its poor lighting and current sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation offers Safe Streets to Transit grant funds to counties and municipalities in order to enhance pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the project described in the City's Safe Streets to Transit 2022 grant application will install new concrete sidewalk, lighting, and increase ADA accessibility; and

WHEREAS, a completed application needs to be accompanied with a certified resolution for approving the City to submit a grant application for funding from the FY2022 Safe Streets to Transit Program and execute a grant contract with the New Jersey Department of Transportation for the City of Orange Township Orange Train Station Underpass Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Orange Township, formally approves the grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as SST-2022-Orange City Township-00044 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Orange Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Orange Township and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
