- 5. Does Orange's new in-person only civic participation policy and procedure foster our State's public policies in favor of robust informed civic participation?

- 8. Based upon posted CY 2021 Ethic Financial Disclosure Statements, how many city employees and public officials hold more than one public position funded by taxpayers' trust fund monies?
- 9. Based upon the recent article about COVID 19 related bonuses being awarded to certain municipal employees, are these COVID 19 related bonus payments included or excluded from the CY 2021 Amended Budget?
- 10. What is the funding source of these additional bonus payments?
- 11. What factors were used to determine the recipients and amounts of these COVID 19 related bonus payments?
- 12. Who ultimately determined and approved the recipients and the amounts of these new COVID 19 related bonuses?
- 13. How much money does the Orange water/sewer utility owe Suez?
- 14. How many different COVID-19/FEMA related reimbursement applications does Orange have outstanding?
- 15. Were any potential water/sewer utility grant applications denied or rendered incomplete due to the failure of certain in-house financial type employees' failure to provide financial information or to sign the appropriate paper work?
- 16. Based upon the two proposed water/sewer related rate increase ordinances posted on the August 4, 2021 regular agenda and without the benefit of the CY 2020 financial statement, is Orange's water/sewer utility still self-liquidating?

- 17. Do the two proposed water/sewer utility related rate increase ordinance include or exclude all announced rate increases announced by any third party provider or supplier?
- 18. Based upon the two proposed water/sewer related rate increase ordinances posted on the August 4, 2021 regular agenda, what will be the projected amount of revenue loss or decline from the proposed municipal/local school board 25% discount?
- 19. Based upon the posted August 4, 2021 Agenda, how much money has Orange expended since July 2016 responding to federal grand jury investigation subpoenas?
- 20. Based upon the posted August 4, 2021 Agenda, how much has Orange expended since October 2016 defending police department civil rights violations claims and causes of action arising under the watch of the municipality's current police director appointed without any public comments in October 2016?
- 21. Based upon the posted August 4, 2021 Agenda, who is responsible for monitoring all pending litigation involving the municipality and the timely adoption of appropriate professional defense services retention resolutions?

- 33. In the next two years, how much will Orange be required to contribute as health care reserves?
- 34. In the next two years, how much COVID-19 related monies does Orange anticipate receiving?

- 36. Who is the water/sewer utility manager?
- 37. Is that water/sewer utility manager qualified under federal and state rules and regulations?
