## **MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION**

Vincent DeFilippo, City of Orange's Health Officer discussed the following updates regarding COVID-19:

- Positive COVID-19 numbers are low in the City of Orange Township;
- Over 50% of Orange residents have been vaccinated (27% of latinos, 4% of whites and over 50% of blacks)
- Adults ages 65 to 80 are the most vulnerable who have passed away;
- Adults ages 30 to 49 are the most testing positive;
- Governor Murphy has lifted mask mandates, but store owners can impose their own policy requirements for masks.
