With respect to the \$500,000 Retirement Severance Special Emergency Appropriation Ord. 60-2021, how many employees are subject to this emergency ordinance, when did they tender their retirement notices, why the delay in approving this municipal legislation until the last day of CY 2021, who determined to pay off this severance obligation in a lump sum and not over 5 years, who determined to pay off this severance obligation via issuance of an emergency note and not via surplus, when will amortization of this special appropriation commence, is this emergency appropriation subject to the discretionary approval of the State Executive Branch, when will this emergency ordinance become effective: upon approval of the mayor, 20 days after published notice of adoption or immediately upon approval?
- 2. With respect to 20 Day Estoppel Waiver and Rescission Res. 530-2021, when did this severance emergency arise and when did someone finally realize that the \$500,000 severance obligation had to be satisfied within and by the close of CY 2021 pursuant to well-established State law?
- 3. With respect to 20 Day Estoppel Waiver and Rescission Res. 530-2021, what is the urgent need to rescind a walk-on Res 529-2021(WO) adopted at the last December 22, 2021 CC meeting?
- 4. With respect to \$17,608,956.15 Bill List Res. 526-2021, why did the local governing body delay consideration and official action on this posted agenda action item on December 22, 2021?
- 5. Why the delay (Dec. 28, 2021) in publicly seeking CY 2022 Budget Consultant Requests for Proposals?
- 6. What is the status of the CY 2020 Audit?
- 7. By delaying the delivery and posting of the CY 2020 Audit and this \$500,000 emergent severance appropriation and long term indebtedness issuance, should Orange have tripped certain State and local Best Practices regulatory circuit breaker bell & whistle alarms?
- 8. Why the delay in preparing and posting monthly and quarterly operating and revenue reports?
