

CITY COUNCIL**The City of Orange Township, New Jersey**DATE March 1, 2022NUMBER 125-2022TITLE: **AMENDED****RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT LOCATED AT 419 CENTRAL AVENUE, ORANGE, NEW JERSEY TO DECOMMISSION AND DISPOSE OF FIRE TRUCKS NO LONGER IN USE BY THE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department is in possession of three (3) fire trucks that have exceeded their operation capacity and, thus, are no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, two fire trucks are now more than 25 years old, and the third is seven years old; and

WHEREAS, aside from the age, all three vehicles are in need of a host of repairs in order to be functional for fire ground operations; and

WHEREAS, the repairs needed for the vehicles exceed the anticipated budget and, given the age of the vehicles, it would not be in the economic interest of the City of Orange Township to engage in such repairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department desires to decommission and dispose of the following items:

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department desires to decommission and dispose the fire trucks listed above due to the existing, extensive physical and mechanical damages; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department has received a quote from Sims Metal Management that this company will pay \$210/gt for the 1995 and 1996 vehicles (see attached). This should yield approximately \$8,000.00 to \$8,750.00 to the City of Orange Township, the actual payment to be determined once the vehicles are physically put on the scale; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township Fire Department determined that the quote proposed from Sims Metal Management is the highest price paid in the surrounding areas for similar vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has advised the Essex County Fire Coordinator of the City of Orange Township's plans with respect to the aforementioned trucks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township hereby authorizes the City of Orange Township Fire Department to decommission and dispose of three (3) fire trucks as described herein that are no longer in use by the department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township hereby authorizes the City of Orange Township Fire Department to use proceeds collected in the purchase of much needed equipment.


