TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 200 ENTITLED "VEHICLES & TRAFFIC," SECTION NO PARKING & PROHIBITED PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS (Sponsored by Council Member Kerry Coley)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orange Township deems it necessary to allow and prohibit residential permit parking on certain streets during certain hours.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 200 of the Code is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 1:

a) §200—32 Schedule I: No Parking

Chapter 200, Section 200-32 Schedule I of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended to include the following:

Chapter 200, Section 200-33 Schedule II of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended to include the following:

b) §200—33 Schedule II: No Parking Certain Times

Washington Street	South	6:30am to 9:00am; Except Saturday <u>Tues., Thurs;</u> <u>9:00am to 12:00pm</u>	Entire Length <u>North Center Street to East Orange line</u>

Section 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, approval and publication according to law.
