TITLE: CAPITAL ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$225,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CAMERA EQUIPMENT, AND PURCHASE OF NEW SIGNAGE AND HOLIDAY DECORATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The capital purposes described in Section 2 of this capital ordinance are hereby authorized as general capital purposes to be undertaken by the City of Orange Township, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey (the "City"). For the said improvements or purposes stated in Section 2 hereof, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$225,000, said amount is now available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the City from a previously adopted budget or budgets of the City.

SECTION 2.

(a) The improvements and purposes hereby authorized are for the (i) purchase and installation of camera equipment throughout the City, (ii) purchase and installation of signage throughout the City for the Public Safety Program, and (iii) purchase of holiday decorations, including, but not limited to, lights, ornaments, and signs.

(b) The above improvements and purposes set forth in Section 2(a) shall also include, but are not limited to, as applicable, all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

SECTION 3.

The expenditure of \$225,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purposes set forth in Section 2 hereof is hereby authorized and approved.

SECTION 4.

The City hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital

budget, as applicable, for the City. The capital or temporary capital budget, as applicable, of the City is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget of the City, a revised capital or temporary capital budget for the City has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption as described in N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.
