TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP CHAPTER 4, SECTION 4-63.1 ENTITLED "OPEN SPACE, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION ADVISORY BOARD" TO UPDATE THE BOARD COMPOSITION. (Sponsored by Council Member Tency A. Eason).

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township previously established the Open Space, Recreation and Historic Preservation Advisory Board to provide recommendations concerning the Municipal Recreation and Open Space Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, a determination has been made that the composition of the advisory board needs to be modified to allow for greater operational efficiencies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Governing Body of the City of Orange Township that the municipal code be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1.

§ 4-63.1. Open Space, Recreation and Historic Preservation Advisory Board.

B. Composition; compensation.

1. The Board shall consist of 15 members, seven of which will be City of Orange Township residents appointed by each member of the City Council, as follows:
 - (a) Director of Planning and Development;
 - (b) City Council Chair;
 - (c) Mayor or his/her designee;
 - (d) Director of Department of Community Services or his/her designee;
 - (e) City Administrator;
 - (f) One member of the Planning Board;
 - (g) Representative from Historic Preservation Commission;
 - (h) Superintendent of the Orange Public Schools or his/her designee; and
 - (i) Seven Orange residents.

SECTION 2. Inconsistencies

All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. Headings

All headings within this ordinance are for convenience only and are not deemed to be part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date
