TITLE: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CANCELLING CAPITAL ORDINANCE #44-2022, FINALLY ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 18, 2022, AND THE \$225,000 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND APPROPRIATION AUTHORIZED THEREIN

WHEREAS, Capital Ordinance Number 44-2022 was duly adopted by the City Council of the City of Orange Township, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey (the "City") on October 18, 2022 (the "Capital Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Capital Ordinance appropriated \$225,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund (the "Capital Improvement Fund") to provide for the installation of camera equipment, and the purchase of new signage and holiday decorations for the City (the "Project") as referenced in Section 2(a) of the Capital Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer desires to appropriate the \$225,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund to finance the Project and, as a result, the City would like to return such monies to the Capital Improvement Fund to be used for other capital purposes; and

WHEREAS, in order to cancel the appropriation, the City wants to cancel and repeal the Capital Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Capital Ordinance Number 44-2022 duly adopted by the City Council of the City on October 18, 2022 is hereby repealed and canceled.

Section 2. The \$225,000 appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund to finance the Project is hereby canceled and such monies are hereby returned to the Capital Improvement Fund to be used for other capital purposes.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

TITLE: CAPITAL ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$225,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CAMERA EQUIPMENT, AND PURCHASE OF NEW SIGNAGE AND HOLIDAY DECORATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The capital purposes described in Section 2 of this capital ordinance are hereby authorized as general capital purposes to be undertaken by the City of Orange Township, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey (the "City"). For the said improvements or purposes stated in Section 2 hereof, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$225,000, said amount is now available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the City from a previously adopted budget or budgets of the City.

SECTION 2.

(a) The improvements and purposes hereby authorized are for the (i) purchase and installation of camera equipment throughout the City, (ii) purchase and installation of signage throughout the City for the Public Safety Program, and (iii) purchase of holiday decorations, including, but not limited to, lights, ornaments, and signs.

(b) The above improvements and purposes set forth in Section 2(a) shall also include, but are not limited to, as applicable, all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

SECTION 3.

The expenditure of \$225,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purposes set forth in Section 2 hereof is hereby authorized and approved.

SECTION 4.

The City hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital
