THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of emergency temporary appropriations for any purposes for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the current calendar year and the date of the adoption of the budget for said year; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt a resolution providing for an emergency temporary appropriation to fund contractual obligations due to Veolia for the operation and maintenance of the City's water and sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in Calendar Year 2023 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 including this resolution totals \$148,520.41 for the Current Fund and \$365,000.00 for the Water/Sewer Utility Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Orange Township in the County of Essex (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made for:

Water/Sewer Operating – Veolia Contractual	<u>\$365,000</u>
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- a. The emergency temporary appropriation in the amount of \$365,000 is hereby made for the purpose of funding contractual obligations due to Veolia for the operation and maintenance of the City's water and sewer systems pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 of the Local Budget Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-1 et seq., as amended and supplemented. The emergency temporary appropriation is being made to meet a pressing need for public expenditure to protect or promote the public health, safety, morals or welfare of the citizens of the City prior to the adoption of the 2023 budget.
- b. Said emergency temporary appropriation shall be provided for in the 2023 budget as adopted except, to the extent, if any, said emergency appropriation is paid or funded through the authorization of bonds or notes as an appropriation authorized by law pursuant to Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq.
- c. That two (2) certified copies of this Resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
