WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township did duly advertise on November 22, 2022 for proposals for Yard Waste Disposal Services pursuant to the specifications; and,

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2022 the City of Orange Township received one (1) public proposal pursuant to specifications furnished prospective bidders from the following:

WHEREAS, there exists a need for disposing of yard waste, specifically leaves and other yard waste within a 3 mile radius of the City of Orange Township since physical proximity is necessary for the economical performance of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works did examine the proposal and determined that Reliable Wood Products, LLC proposal complied with the Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, Reliable Wood Products, LLC. has completed and submitted a Business Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City in the previous one (1) year, except that the year 2005 is an exception to this requirement as the one year immediately proceeding the effective date of the Law, as that term is defined below, and that the contract will prohibit Reliable Wood Products, LLC from making any reportable contributions throughout the term of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Orange Township has prepared the necessary Certificate of Availability of Funds, a copy of which is attached hereto, certifying that funds will be available for this purpose in Account No.3-01-26-305-000-528, contingent upon Council approval and inclusion of said item in the Temporary Budget and adopted 2023 Budget, there will be sufficient funds to contract with Reliable Wood Products, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township, that a contract be awarded to Reliable Wood Products, LLC, 1106 Millstone River Road, Hillsborough, New Jersey 08844; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper officers of the City of Orange Township are hereby authorized to enter into said contract with Reliable Wood Products, LLC for yard

waste disposal services upon condition that bidder comply fully with all terms and conditions of the specifications in an amount not to exceed \$112,312.50.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain a firm for the purpose of **disposing of yard waste, specifically leaves and other yard waste** in the City of Orange Township, as specifically set forth in the attached proposal.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain **Reliable Wood Products, LLC.** with offices located at **1106 Millstone River Road, Hillsborough, New Jersey 08844**, the lowest responsible bidder of bidders to submitting for such service on December 7, 2022.

WHEREAS, this firm and the individuals of the firm are to be retained pursuant to the Agreement as specified by the attached proposal dated December 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orange Township has, by **Resolution No. _____** dated _____, authorizes **Reliable Wood Products, LLC** to provide the **facilities for disposing of yard waste, which is located at the Township of West Orange Composting/Recycling Facility, 590 Mount Pleasant Avenue, West Orange, New Jersey 07052** as specified in the attached proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED by and between the parties, for the mutual convenient set forth herein below:

1. **Reliable Wood Products, LLC** is hereby contracted by the City of Orange Township to provide services as specified in the attached proposal.

2. This agreement shall be effective commencing on **January 1, 2023** and terminating on **December 31, 2023**.
3. This agreement shall not be assigned nor shall any duties under this agreement be delegated by **Reliable Wood Products, LLC** without prior written consent of the City.
4. The validity of this agreement and its terms or provisions, as well as the rights and duties of the contracting parties, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
5. This agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the contracting parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns when not expressly prohibited by this agreement.
6. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of it this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in it.
7. This agreement constitutes the sole agreement of the contracting parties and supersedes any prior understandings or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting its subject matter.
8. All notices and other communications shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, and shall be deemed to have been given when sent to the parties at their respective addresses as set forth above, unless a different

address has been selected after the execution of this agreement and has been duly communicated to the party giving notice.

9. The City may terminate this Agreement upon three days notice with **Reliable Wood Products, LLC**. In the event that this agreement is deemed to be terminated, the City shall pay **Reliable Wood Products, LLC** for those services provided as of the effective date of termination. This agreement is final and cannot be amended, supplemented, changed or modified without said being in writing.



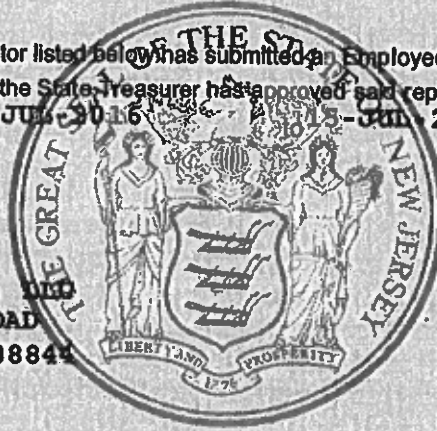



6. As used in sections 2 through 12 of this act:

"business entity" means any natural or legal person, business corporation, professional services corporation, limited liability company, partnership, limited partnership, business trust, association or any other legal commercial entity organized under the laws of this State or of any other state or foreign jurisdiction;

"interest" means the ownership or control of more than 10% of the profits or assets of a business entity or 10% of the stock in the case of a business entity that is a corporation for profit, as appropriate;

Temporary and Executing

12. Nothing contained in this act shall be construed as affecting the eligibility of any business entity to perform a public contract because that entity made a contribution to any committee during the one-year period immediately preceding the effective date of this act.

19:44A-3 Definitions. In pertinent part...

p. The term "political party committee" means the State committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S. 19:5-4, any county committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S. 19:5-3, or any municipal committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S. 19:5-2.


q. The term "candidate committee" means a committee established pursuant to subsection a. of section 9 of P.L. 1973, c.83 (C. 19:44A-9) for the purpose of receiving contributions and making expenditures.

r. the term "joint candidates committee" means a committee established pursuant to subsection a. of section 9 of P.L. 1973, c.83 (C. 19:44A-9) by at least two candidates for the same elective public offices in the same election in a legislative district, county, municipality or school district, but not more candidates than the total number of the same elective public offices to be filled in that election, for the purpose of receiving contributions and making expenditures. For the purpose of this subsection: ...; the offices of member of the board of chosen freeholders and county executive shall be deemed to be the same elective public offices in a county; and the offices of mayor and member of the municipal governing body shall be deemed to be the same elective public offices in a municipality.

19:44A-8 and 16 Contributions, expenditures, reports, requirements.

While the provisions of this section are too extensive to reprint here, the following is deemed to be the pertinent part affecting amounts of contributions:

"The \$300 limit established in this subsection shall remain as stated in this subsection without further adjustment by the commission in the manner prescribed by section 22 of P.L. 1993, c.65 (C. 19:44A-7.2)


