**WHEREAS**, the City of Orange Township did duly advertise on November 22, 2022 for proposals for car washing services to all City Owned vehicles pursuant to the specifications; and,

**WHEREAS**, on December 7, 2022 the City of Orange Township received one (1) public proposal for car washing services from the following:

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works did examine the proposal and determined that KC's Car Wash's proposal complied with the Local Public Contracts Law; and,

**WHEREAS**, KC's Car Wash has completed and submitted a Business Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City in the previous one (1) year, except that the year 2005 is an exception to this requirement as the one year immediately proceeding the effective date of the Law, as that term is defined below, and that the contract will prohibit KC's Car Wash from making any reportable contributions throughout the term of the contract; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Orange Township has prepared the necessary Certificate of Availability of Funds, a copy of which is attached hereto, certifying that funds will be available for this purpose in Account No. 3-01-26-315-000-528, contingent upon Council approval and inclusion of said item in the Temporary Budget and adopted 2023 Budget, there will be sufficient funds to contract with KC's Car Wash.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain a firm for the purpose for car washing services to all City owned vehicles in the City of Orange Township, as specifically set forth in the attached specifications in the amount not to exceed \$10,000.00.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain **KC's Car Wash** with offices located at 360 Thomas Boulevard, Orange, New Jersey 07050, the lowest responsible bidder of bidders to submitting for such service on December 7, 2022.

**WHEREAS**, this firm and the individuals of the firm are to be retained pursuant to the Agreement as specified by the attached specifications dated December 7, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Orange Township has, by **Resolution # \_\_\_\_\_** dated \_\_\_\_\_, authorizes **KC's Car Was** for providing car washing services to all City owned vehicles specified in the attached specifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED** by and between the parties, for the mutual convenient set forth herein below:

1. **KC's Car Wash** is hereby contracted by the City of Orange Township to provide services as specified in the attached specifications.
2. This agreement shall be effective commencing on January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

3. This agreement shall not be assigned nor shall any duties under this agreement be delegated by **KC's Car Wash** without prior written consent of the City.
4. The validity of this agreement and its terms or provisions, as well as the rights and duties of the contracting parties, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
5. This agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the contracting parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns when not expressly prohibited by this agreement.
6. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of it this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in it.
7. This agreement constitutes the sole agreement of the contracting parties and supersedes any prior understandings or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting its subject matter.
8. All notices and other communications shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, and shall be deemed to have been given when sent to the parties at their respective addresses as set forth above, unless a different address has been selected after the execution of this agreement and has been duly communicated to the party giving notice.
9. The City may terminate this Agreement upon three days notice with American Wear, Inc. In the event that this agreement is deemed to be terminated, the

City shall pay **KC's Car Wash** for those services provided as of the effective date of termination.

The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor will send to each labor union, with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union of the contractor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

**19:44A-20.6 Certain contributions deemed as contributions by business entity.**

5. When a business entity is a natural person, a contribution by that person's spouse or child, residing therewith, shall be deemed to be a contribution by the business entity. When a business entity is other than a natural person, a contribution by any person or other business entity having an interest therein shall be deemed to be a contribution by the business entity.

**19:44A-20.7 Definitions relative to certain campaign contributions.**

6. As used in sections 2 through 12 of this act:

"business entity" means any natural or legal person, business corporation, professional services corporation, limited liability company, partnership, limited partnership, business trust, association or any other legal commercial entity organized under the laws of this State or of any other state or foreign jurisdiction;

"interest" means the ownership or control of more than 10% of the profits or assets of a business entity or 10% of the stock in the case of a business entity that is a corporation for profit, as appropriate;

**Temporary and Executing**

12. Nothing contained in this act shall be construed as affecting the eligibility of any business entity to perform a public contract because that entity made a contribution to any committee during the one-year period immediately preceding the effective date of this act.

**The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq.)**

**19:44A-3 Definitions. In pertinent part...**

p. The term "political party committee" means the State committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S.19:5-4, any county committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S.19:5-3, or any municipal committee of a political party, as organized pursuant to R.S.19:5-2.

q. The term "candidate committee" means a committee established pursuant to subsection a. of section 9 of P.L.1973, c.83 (C.19:44A-9) for the purpose of receiving contributions and making expenditures.

For the purpose of this subsection: ...; the offices of member of the board of chosen freeholders and county executive shall be deemed to be the same elective public offices in a county; and the offices of mayor and member of the municipal governing body shall be deemed to be the same elective public offices in a municipality.
