AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, between the City of Orange Township and **Denville Line Painting, Inc., 2 Green Pond Road, Rockaway, New Jersey 07866.**

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain a firm for the purpose of **traffic striping under the MCCPC#36** for the City of Orange Township, as specifically set forth in the attached proposal in the amount not to exceed **\$30,000.00**.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township wishes to retain **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** with offices located at **2 Green Pond Road, Rockaway, New Jersey 07866.**

WHEREAS, this firm and the individuals of the firm are to be retained pursuant to the Agreement as specified under the **MCCPC#36**; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orange Township has, by **Resolution No. _____** dated _____, authorizes **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** for the purpose of **traffic striping**, as specified in the attached proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED by and between the parties, for the mutual convenient set forth herein below:

1. **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** is hereby contracted by the City of Orange Township to provide services as specified in the attached proposal.
2. This agreement shall be effective commencing on **January 1, 2023** and terminating on **December 31, 2023.**
3. This agreement shall not be assigned nor shall any duties under this agreement be delegated by **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** without prior written consent of the City.

4. The validity of this agreement and its terms or provisions, as well as the rights and duties of the contracting parties, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
5. This agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the contracting parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns when not expressly prohibited by this agreement.
6. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of it this agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in it.
7. This agreement constitutes the sole agreement of the contracting parties and supersedes any prior understandings or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting its subject matter.
8. All notices and other communications shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, and shall be deemed to have been given when sent to the parties at their respective addresses as set forth above, unless a different address has been selected after the execution of this agreement and has been duly communicated to the party giving notice.
9. The City may terminate this Agreement upon three days notice with **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** In the event that this agreement is deemed to be terminated, the City shall pay **Denville Line Painting, Inc.** for those services provided as of the effective

date of termination. This agreement is final and cannot be amended, supplemented, changed or modified without said being in writing.

General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,

- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax.
