Each person addressing the Commission shall give his or her name and address in an audible tone for the record, and unless further time is granted by the presiding officer shall limit his or her address to five (5) minutes unless the comments are repetitive of other witnesses in which case the presiding officer may further limit the comment period.

A. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – A2151-23 406 Clarendon Place, Block 4902, Lot 1, Montrose Seven Oaks Park Historic District

(Paint Garage, Replace garage door, window and shingles) (Owner – Steven Dowd, Kathy

Cooper)

(Public Hearing)

Janine Bauer, Esq., alerted the Commissioners and the public that the applicant, Kathy Dowd is a Commissioner for the Historic Preservation Commission and she would be testifying as a fact witness and not judging this application as she is disqualified to judge. Commissioners should treat Ms. Dowd without sympathy or favoritism. Kathy Dowd was sworn in by Janine Bauer, Esq., Board Attorney.

Kathy Dowd prefaced her information that the application was being submitted after some of the repairs were completed. The applicants employed a contractor to look at the garage because it was shifting and unstable. In order to do the repairs, the contractor needed to remove the siding and shingles of the garage. The garage was reframed, the footing was remedied, and the garage was put back together. Cedar siding was installed on the left side of the garage which is visible to the street. The window and door was also replaced on the left side. Pine siding was installed on the right side. After these items were complete the applicant received notice from the construction office that they needed to obtain a permit, and in order to receive a permit they must file an application with the Historic Preservation Commission. The roof was replaced with asphalt shingles which is the original material. This was a reconstruction of both sides of the garage. The size, the foot print, and the roof are exactly the same. The only difference is that the left side was replaced with cedar instead of pine.

A motion to approve the application Nunc pro tunc as a reconstruction of the left and right sides of the garage with a new roof based on the fact that like kind materials were used and all the same dimensions were kept for the window and door. The only difference being the cedar siding used on the left side and the right side remained pine was made by Commissioner Keith Carroll and seconded by Commissioner Janice Morrell.

B. Certificate of Appropriateness Application – A2152-23

436 New England Terrace, Block 4103, Lot 10, Montrose Seven Oaks Historic District (Replace Windows) (Chaz Hills Dozier – Home Depot/Scott Doughman Contractor) (Public Hearing)

Chaz Hills Dozier, Jose Ruiz, and Andrew Petrides the Home Depot Representative, were all sworn in by Janine Bauer, Esq., Board Attorney.

Mr. Chaz Hills Dozier stated that the home was just purchased two months ago and discovered the ten window in the front are storm windows which means they are not the most energy efficient or visually pleasing. They contacted Home Depot to replace the windows and during the course of getting an estimate, they discovered they needed to appear before the Historic Preservation Commission. There are five panels with ten windows. Andrew Petrides stated there are ten double hung windows. What is

currently installed is temporary windows. The windows are visible from the street. Two, Three and Four or visible from the street. The windows will be hung with insulated double hung windows. The purpose is two-fold, to improve the look and to increase the efficiency of the house. The windows will be white interior and exterior and the same dimensions as windows currently installed. Window one is installed on the front left side of the house – the door is actually on the left side of the house.
