Sealed bids will be received at Orange City Hall, 29 North Day Street, Council Chambers, 4th Floor, Orange, New Jersey on **Tuesday, April 4, 2023**, at prevailing time mentioned above, at which time they shall be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter.

Bidders may inspect and obtain specifications from the Department of Public Works, 29 North Day Street, Room #304, Orange, New Jersey between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday commencing on the date of this notice. Contract documents may be obtained only from the Department of Public Works and Engineering and hours set forth above upon payment of a non refundable fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) by cash, check or money order payable to the City of Orange Township.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of NJSA 10:5-31 et seq. and Affirmative Action requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127 (NJAC 17:27 et seq.) and Local Unit Pay-To-Play Law (P.L. 2004, c19, as amended by P.L. 2005, c51). All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside, "Refuse and Recycling Collection Services".

Bidders seeking the award of this contract must be registered with the State of New Jersey pursuant to the State Business Registration Act. A certificate showing proof of registration must be included in all bid proposals.

Bids will be received at the hour named, not before or after and **NO BIDS SHALL BE RECEIVED BY MAIL OR FAX.**

Each bid must be accompanied by the Consent of Surety Form and a guarantee which shall be in the amount of 10% of the bid, but not in excess of \$20,000.00, except as otherwise provided herein, and may be given, at the option of the bidder by certified check, cashier's check or bid bond made payable to the City of Orange Township.

Bidders must use and fully complete the proposal pages included with specifications furnished by the owner with all requirements attached thereto. Failure to do so will constitute grounds of disqualification.

The City Council of the City of Orange Township reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any informalities or irregularities in bids received which in their opinion will be in the best interest of the City of Orange Township, or for reasons required by law.
