- 4. The Site Plan shall be updated to reflect all changes agreed to at the hearing and the Board Professionals' reports, if any.
- 5. All other State, County, and Municipal regulatory agency reviews that may be necessary must be obtained.
- 6. No construction permits of any type shall be issued by the Construction Code Official of the City of Orange Township until all Board escrow fees have been paid, a Resolution of Approval has been memorialized and appropriately signed by the Board, and the Construction Code Official has received final plans appropriately signed by the Board Chairman, Board Secretary, and Board Engineer.


