Our Cartificate of Incosporation, affective May 19, 1991 is with the State of New Jersey (here after called M.I.C.).

The Municipal Inspection Corporation shall:

- 1.0 Perform routine, periodic and final acceptance tests per ASME A17.1 section 10, as specified in N.J.A.C. 5:23-12, and any existing local ordinances.
- 2.0 Record data from such tests and inspections on the U.C.C. form F310-1. Forward reports to the building owner or his agent and one copy to the Construction Official's office.
- 3.0 Issue the standard U.C.C. "Notice of Violation" for any device found not to be in compliance with applicable codes, as required in N.J.A.C. 5:23-2.30. It is understood that the Construction Official shall sign all Notices of Penalty.
- 4.0 Re-inspect any facility, once violations are abated, and issue a supplemental inspection report to the building owner or this agent, and one copy to the Construction Official's office.
- 5.0 Perform "Plan Reviews" within (5) business day of acceptance of said plans, as specified in N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.4.
- 6.0 Assist building owners in registering their devices with the Department, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:23-12.4.
- 7.0 Carry liability insurance in the amounts specified in N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.14(e)5.
- 8.0 Upon full payment of all fines and fees, M.I.C. shall, in the name of the Municipality, produce the "Certificate of Compliance" for signing and mailing by the Construction Official.

AGREEMENT CONTINUED:

The Municipality shall:

- 1.0 Provide M.I.C. with all known addresses and locations of each elevator device to Be inspected within the Municipality.
- 2.0 Provide the name and address of the building owner or his authorized agent.
- 3.0 Have the sole responsibility to affirmatively seal or order scaling of any elevator device, which pose imminent danger of accident and or may create an unreasonable risk of injury to persons or property, upon proper notice by M.L.C.
- 4.0 Provide copies of any local ordinances or regulations relating to elevator devices.
- 5.0 Conduct the administration and enforcement of violations, with regard to fines, fees and time periods for abatement, through the Construction Official's office.
- 6.0 As stated in Construction Code Communicator Volume 4 Number 3, Fall of 1992, Municipalities must mail requests, receive and record checks, and issue Certificate.

Upon receipt of all inspection reports, inspection log sheets, and submittal of verified Municipal Voucher, the municipality shall pay Municipal Inspection Corporation the fee based on 90-percent (90%) of the new DCA fee schedule established by the Department of Community Affairs and in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.20. Accordingly, the municipality shall retain 50 percent 50 %) administrative fee.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.14(i) and (j), the Contract shall provide that amounts due to the private agency shall be billed within 30 days of coming due and paid within 30 days of billing.
