TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 200-32, CHAPTER 200-33, CHAPTER 200-35, AND CHAPTER 200-52.3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Orange Township to regulate, in a manner consistent with the interests of the citizens of the City of Orange Township, the location of on street parking permit locations.

WHEREAS, the area of Glenwood Avenue currently has parking restrictions;

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township, in conjunction with Remington and Vernick Engineers, has determined that an increase in permit parking is safe and in the best interests of residents in the surrounding area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 200-32, Chapter 200-33, Chapter 200-35, and Chapter 200-52.3 of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended and supplemented as follows:

Recommendation for Parking Plan along Glenwood Avenue

Dear Mr. Mobley:

At the request of the Township, representatives of our office reviewed the existing conditions of the above captioned roadway to address on-street parking concerns. Specifically, to evaluate the roadway and determine the feasibility of permit parking.

Glenwood Avenue is a 28-foot-wide road that is approximately 615 feet long from Main Street to the East Orange line. Glenwood Avenue intersects with William Street. Per the City code, the following parking restrictions are currently in place:
