**TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 200, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", SECTION 200-10.2, RESIDENTIAL PERMIT. (Walsh Avenue) (Sponsored by Council Member Weldon M. Montague, III)**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orange Township deems it necessary to allow residential permit parking on certain streets during certain hours.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 200 of the Code is amended and supplemented as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

**a) § 200-10.2. Residential Permit Parking Zone A.**

Chapter 200, Section 200-10.2 of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended to include one (1) additional street as follows:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>Walsh Avenue</u>	<u>Both</u>	<u>7:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.</u>	<u>Entire Length</u>

Motor vehicles with the decal prominently displayed in the rear window shall be entitled to be parked without limitation as to hours parked, between the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m. on the streets or portions of streets within Residential Parking Permit Zone A.

**SECTION 2. Severability of Ordinance Provisions**

Each section of this ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity of constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

**SECTION 3. Conflict of Other Ordinance Provisions**

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions**

That this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided
