**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT FOR THE REMOVAL OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING SERVICES WITH JOSEPH SMENTKOWSKI, INC., 160 JAMES AVENUE, JERSEY CITY, NEW JERSEY 07306 FOR AN ADDITIONAL NINETY DAY (90) PERIOD COMMENCING JUNE 1, 2023 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2023 IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$345,000.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the extension of the contract between the City of Orange Township and Joseph Smentkowski, Inc., 160 James Avenue, Jersey City, New Jersey 07306, for Solid Waste and Recycling Services expires on May 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the provision of Solid Waste and Recycling Services is a service that must be bid under the Local Public Contracts Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the current vendor, Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. has agreed to obtain an extension; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that an additional ninety day period will be required in order to properly award the Solid Waste and Recycling Services; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result, the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township authorized the execution and delivery of an extended contract with Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. and such contract is authorized by N.J.S.A., 40A:11-6; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Orange Township has prepared the necessary Certificate of Availability of Funds, a copy of which is attached hereto, certifying that funds will be available for this purpose in Account No. 3-01-26-305-000-528, contingent upon Council approval and inclusion of said item in the Temporary Budget and adopted 2023 Budget, there will be sufficient funds to contract with Joseph Smentkowski, Inc.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township does authorize the extension of the contract with Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. for the Solid Waste and Recycling Services for the City of Orange Township, in the amount not to exceed \$345,000.00 for an additional ninety days commencing June 1, 2023 through August 31, 2023.

## Purpose of Form
