TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 6-2022 AND STATE THE CORRECT PARK TO BE REFURBISHED.

WHEREAS, the Code of the City of Orange Township ("Municipal Code") currently has Ordinance 6-2022, stating Metcalf Park as the Park to be refurbished and,

WHEREAS, the Park to be refurbished is Colgate Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW JEREY as follows:

Section 1 Amendment to Ordinance 6-2022

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township has received an offer from OMAR SHARIFFE COOPER, THE LIFESTYLE SPORTS AGENCY, AND ADIDAS AG., to donate certain capital improvements to METCALF PARK COLGATE PARK, specifically the METCALF PARK COLGATE PARK Basketball Amenity located in the CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP; and

WHEREAS, the improvements to Metcalf Park Colgate Park are anticipated to include but not necessarily be limited to the following:

- 1. New rims and backboards with the ADIDAS logo.
- 2. New basketball court resurfacing/spackling.
- 3. The erection of court side seating/stands surrounding the basketball court(s).

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council has considered such an offer and has concluded that the acceptance of the donation of the capital improvements aforesaid is in the public interest and is authorized by N.J.S.A 40A:12-5 by gift; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council finds that the acceptance of the aforesaid gift is authorized by law and desires to acknowledge and authorize the CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP's acquisition of the capital improvements;

- 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the Municipal Clerk to attest any and all documents that are necessary in order to effectuate the acquisition of these Capital Improvements, provided that said documents are in a form acceptable to the City Attorney prior to final execution.
- 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
- 4. That, in the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the Ordinance actually adjudged to be invalid, and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall not be affected.


