WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes was a remedial and language arts teacher for the South Orange Board Education during the years of 1965-1966; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes was a secondary social studies teacher for Orange High School during the years of 1966-1969; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes was vice principal at Orange High School during the years of 1969-1972; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes was principal of Orange High School during the years of 1973-1975; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes was assistant superintendent, for the Orange Board Education, during the years of 1975-1990; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morris Holmes was interim superintendent for the Orange Board Education in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Erline Morrison Holmes retired from the Orange Board in Education in 1990; and
