AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 200, ENTITLED "VEHICLES & TRAFFIC," SECTION 200-10.2 RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT & PROHIBITED PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS (Sponsored by Councilmember Weldon M. Montague, III)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orange Township deems it necessary to allow and prohibit residential permit parking on certain streets during certain hours.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 200 of the Code is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 200, Section 200-10.2 of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended to include one (1) additional street as follows:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours</u>	<u>Location</u>
Walsh Avenue	Both (Alternate Side)	5:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.	Entire Street

Motor vehicles with a decal prominently displayed in the rear window shall be entitled to be parked without limitation as to hours parked, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. on the street referenced above.

Section 2:

Any Ordinance inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, approval and publication according to law.
