1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Agreement with American Forensic Engineering (AFE) in an amount not to exceed \$214,615.00.



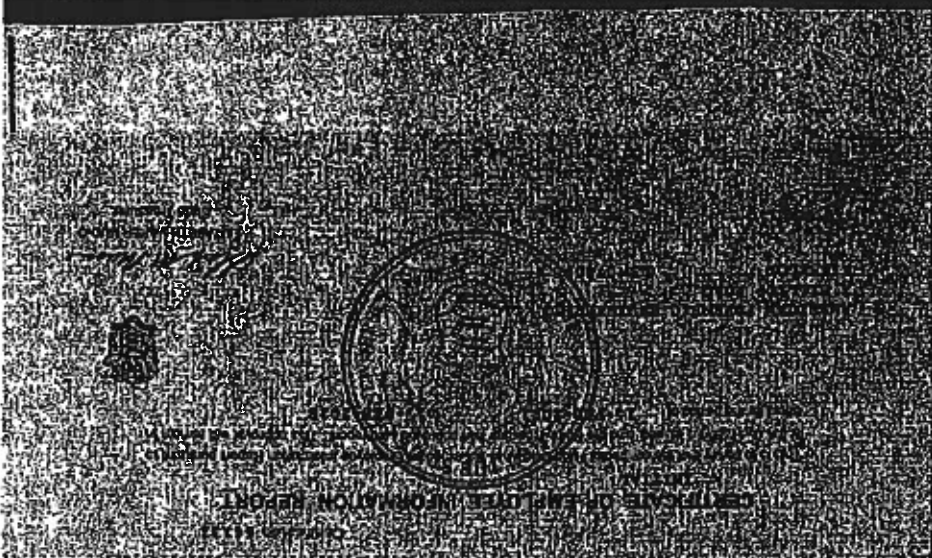
