**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs published a notice of funding for the FY2023 American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 10, 2023 the City of Orange Township submitted an application requesting grant funds to purchase turnout gear. Firefighters rely on the sets of PPE when responding to all emergency calls, as it provides essential protection from smoke and carcinogenic contaminants; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 18, 2023 the City of Orange Township was awarded \$116,136.75 in grant funds to purchase firefighter turnout gear to assist in the protection of our firefighters; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Orange Township is required to provide a 10% match of total grant award.
