WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township did duly advertise on September 25, 2023 for public bids for Refuse and Recycling Collection Services; and,

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2023 the City of Orange Township two (2) public bids pursuant to specification furnished to prospective bidders from the following:

WHEREAS, the Law Department, did duly examine the bids and determined that Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. is in compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law; and,

WHEREAS, Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. did furnish to the City of Orange Township with an Affirmative action Affidavit, 10% Stockholder Affidavit, Affidavit of Non-Collusion; and,

WHEREAS, Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. has completed and submitted a Business Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City of Orange Township in the previous one (1) year, except that the year 2005 is an exception to this requirement as the one year immediately proceeding the effective date of the Law, as that term is defined below, and that the contract will prohibit Joseph Smentkowski, Inc. from making any reportable contributions throughout the term of the contract; and,

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



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

"Governing body" means the governing body of the municipality, when the contract or agreement is to be entered into by, or on behalf of a, municipality as further defined at N.J.A.C. 40A:11-2.

"Holiday" means a regularly scheduled collection day on which the authorized Disposal Facilities are closed, including:

New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

The following materials may be found in construction and demolition waste: treated and untreated wood scrap; tree parts, tree stumps and brush; concrete, asphalt, bricks, blocks and other masonry; plaster and wallboard; roofing materials; corrugated cardboard and miscellaneous paper; ferrous and non-ferrous metal; non-asbestos building insulation; plastic scrap; dirt; carpets and padding; glass (window and door); and other miscellaneous materials; but shall not include other solid waste types.
- v. 23 Vegetative waste: Waste materials from farms, plant nurseries and greenhouses that are produced from the raising of plants. This waste includes such crop residues as plant stalks, hulls, leaves and tree wastes processed through a wood chipper. Also included are non-crop residues such as leaves, grass clippings, tree parts, shrubbery and garden wastes.
