

The City of Orange Township is seeking a 2023 Essex County Community Development 65ock Reprogramming Grant for the Central Avenue Playground Improvement Project, which involves the rehabilization and modification of various amenities at Orange's Contral Avenue Playground and Park, Central Avenue Playground is located in the City of Orange Township, in Census Tract 156, Census Tract 156 has 3,977 residents. Over 82% of these residents, or 3,285 residents, are considered fow-moderate income (1MI).

As Crange has high population density and many residents that the within low / moderate income households, the local population relies on public spaces close to home to access recreation opportunities. The current playground at Control Avenue Playground is in need of improvement to meet the current and future needs of the surrounding community. This forces many families living sear the park to bring their children to updated playground locations further away, or not go out at all.

Because the Orange is such a densely populated township, with 15,565 residents per square mile, it is imperative to Improve infrastructure within the Township's local playgrounds, parks, and open speces. The Orange Department of Public Works and Engineering Departments has identified that Central Avenue Playground is in need of urgest public improvement.

The goal of the proposed project is to increase use of the playground for families and children, to promote public improvement of Oranga's open spaces, and to create opportunities for the Township to continue investing in safe, family-infendly public spaces.

The proposed project includes the following improvements to the Central Avenue Phyground:

- The existing wrought iron perimeter fence is rusted and needs to be rehabilitated. The current fence will be removed
 to be restored/repainted. The fence will be modified to remove the buthress supports which create tripping hazards
 before it is reinstalled.
- A deteriorated section of 6" fence, which is in poor condition as compared to the ediporat fence, will be replaced with a 10" high fance. The height of the new fence will be increased to keep errent volleyballs on the volleyball court.
- A new 2012(2) shade structure will provide a uscable space for activities and for parents / guardians to rest out of the direct light of the sun. Chairs and tables will be installed.
- Pavernent areas beneath the proposed shade structure and around the tree seat well will be replaced with concrete sidewall. These areas of powernent are detailorated and have created tripping hazards that need to be addressed.
 Concrete will be used to connect the park entrance with the adjacent wellway.
- The existing landscape planters along the park embancs are proposed to be reconfigured to enhance pedestrian

The City of Orange Township is home to significant special populations including youth and elderly populations, many of whom rely on their local parts for recreation, rest, and releasation. In Grange, 25-9% of the population or, 8,722 people, are aged 15 or under, and additionally 13.4% of the population, or 4,512 people, are aged 65 years and over.

The project includes improvements to the park. Thus, the improved park will be open to and primarily utilized by all residents of Grange, the majority of whom reside in low to moderate income households.

0.1. How does this proposed project fit the needs of the pupulation to be served? Given that Orange is one of the most densely populated municipalities in the state and the netion, with a population of 15,365 residents per square mile, it is essential to offer a quality infrastructure within the Township's local parks and open spaces.

The park is located in a densely populated and hanvily-built low to moderate knoome neighborhood. Renovating the existing park will increase recreational opportunities within the park, as well as the well-being of the park for families with children, or the elderly population who rely on the park at a construntly space to relat.

D.A. How are the target population's needs exercised

The Township's Department of Public Works and consulting engineer have assessed the park conditions and proposed improvements based on the Township's Master Plan, which recommends the Orange give attention to the use, condition, and well-being of parks, open-space environments, and complete timely and necessary upgrades where needed.

The Yownship is also committed to licturalize to the priorities of residents through public surveys and hearings, where residents can make requests or needs known, as well as advocate for specific project or attention to an area of need.
