TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND NON-OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO GREATER ESSEX COUNSELING SERVICES TO PROVIDE MENTAL AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP FROM APRIL 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., requires a resolution authorizing the award of contracts for professional services without competitive bidding, and that the contract itself be available for public inspection as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, The City of Orange Township recognized the pressing need for comprehensive opioid treatment services for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Greater Essex Counseling Services is a reputable and licensed facility specializing in substance use and co-occurring disorders; and

WHEREAS, collaboration between the City of Orange and Greater Essex Counseling Services is deemed essential to address the opioid crisis and enhance the well-being of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer, of the City of Orange Township has prepared the necessary Certificate of Availability of Funds, a copy of which is attached hereto, certifying that monies are available in Account No. G-02-41-779-000-024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP that the Agreement is hereby approved in accordance with its terms and the Mayor and all other required City officials are hereby authorized to execute same on behalf of the City; and

1. The agreement shall commence on the date of the within Resolution and until such time as either the funding in the amount of \$50,000.00 has been exhausted, the expiration date of June 30, 2024 has been reached or one of the two parties choose to terminate by providing written notes to the other party thirty (30) days in advance of the termination date with provisions for renewal upon mutual agreement.
2. The services to be provided by Greater Essex Counseling Services shall include, but are not limited to, screening, assessment, early intervention, OP/IOP treatment/recovery, medication-assisted treatment (MAT), counseling, aftercare support, harm reduction and dental services. In addition, social services needs are met through the use of on-site case managers.

Purpose:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) outlines the terms and conditions under which **Greater Essex Counseling Services** and the **City of Orange** agree to collaborate to provide services to residents of the City of Orange suffering from opioid use disorder. Payment for services by the City of Orange to Greater Essex Counseling Services shall not exceed \$50,000.00 from the date of this agreement through June 30, 2024.

Scope of Collaboration:

1. Services to be Provided:

The City of Orange has outlined a need for services for residents suffering from opioid use disorder.

Greater Essex Counseling Services is an OP/IOP treatment facility providing substance use and co-occurring disorder treatment incorporating evidence-based practices utilizing MI (Motivational Interviewing), CBT (Cognitive Behavioral Therapy) and MAT (Medication Assisted Treatment) modalities in the treatment of its clients.



The services under this agreement include, screening, assessment, early intervention, OP/IOP treatment/recovery, harm reduction as well as dental services. In addition, social service needs are met through the use of our on-site case managers.

Assistance will be provided to the City of Orange residents based on financial eligibility through data collected at the time client screening is conducted. Services provided will include:

1. The City of Orange will provide transportation to its residents in need to and from Greater Essex Dental LLC every Tuesday from 9am to 1pm at which time Greater Essex Dental will conduct screenings, x-rays and exams to determine each client's dental needs and clients will be assisted with services such as extractions, root canals, and dentures. This program will cover services for a total of 20 patients who reside in the City of Orange.
2. Mobile outreach will be conducted in four (4) of the City of Orange's identified "hot spots" once each week by Greater Essex staff including a CADC and a Peer Recovery Specialist who will engage with residents and homeless populations to link them with care needs relating to substance use disorder treatment: detox, in-patient, out-patient and other social services including documentation, housing, employment, etc.
3. Harm reduction services will be provided and supplied by Greater Essex Counseling Services in the form of 100 safe sex kits, 100 fentanyl testing strips, 48 Narcan kits and Narcan trainings. All supplies will be provided to the City of Orange Health Department.

Data Tracking:

Data will be tracked and reported on a monthly basis. Each client will be provided with a unique identifying number within the Greater Essex Counseling Services system. The data tracked will include the following criteria:

- Entry Date
- Discharge Date
- Discharge Status (complete/dropped out/referred out)
- Age
- Gender
- Ethnicity
