**TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER §200-32 AND CHAPTER §200-38 OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP CODE (Frankfort Street)**

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the City of Orange Township to regulate, in a manner consistent with the interests of the citizens of the City of Orange Township, the location of One-Way Streets in the City;

**WHEREAS**, Representatives from Remington & Vernick Engineers performed a site visit on North Jefferson Street to investigate a request to convert Frankfort Street to a One-Way Street;

**WHEREAS**, Representatives from Remington & Vernick performed their on-site visit and are recommending Frankfort Street be converted into a One-Way Street;

**WHEREAS**, the below changes will allow for additional parking and help to alleviate congestion;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, that Chapter §200-32 of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended and supplemented as follows; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, that Chapter §200-38 is amended to and supplemented as follows.

*200-32 Schedule I: No Parking*

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Limits
Frankfort Street	North	From Lincoln Avenue, west for 50 feet. From Scotland Road, east for 40 feet.
Frankfort Street	South	From Lincoln Avenue, west for 50 feet. From Scotland Road, east for 15 feet.

*200-38 Schedule VII: One-Way Streets*

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Limits
Frankfort Street	East	From Scotland Road to Lincoln Avenue

**Purpose:** Increase parking for residents and alleviate congestion.

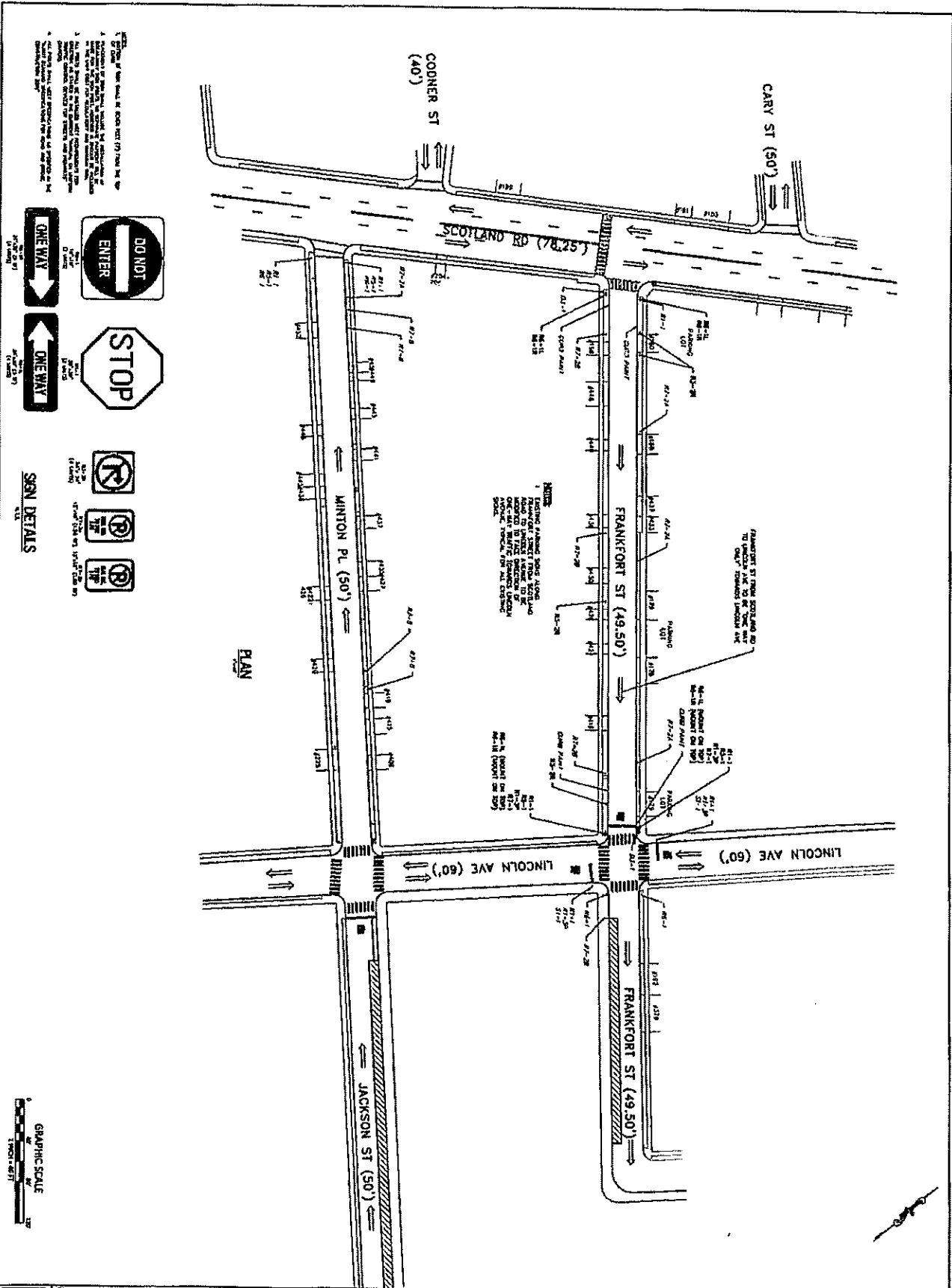
