WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township needs to supply officers with bullet proof vests and replace bullet proof vests that have expired; and

WHEREAS, an application to apply for grant funds was submitted to the US Federal Government, Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the US Federal Government, Department of Justice in Washington D.C awarded the City of Orange Township grant funds for 2022 in the amount \$29,824.48 and 2023 in the amount \$19,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the awarded funds will permit the City of Orange Township Police Department to purchase bullet proof vests for new officers and replaced expired bullet proof vests for existing officers; and

WHEREAS, the funds were awarded for the years 2022 and 2023.

The New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety is pleased to announce that your agency will receive \$9,458.34 under the State Fiscal Year 2023 State Body Armor Replacement Fund (BARF) Program. An electronic transfer of funds or an award check has been sent directly to your agency's Chief Financial Officer.

The State BARF Program assists all eligible law enforcement agencies to offset the costs of purchasing body vests for their officers. Although this is a five-year vest replacement program, program regulations encourage agencies to make every reasonable effort to expend their awards within one year of receipt.

By applying for the 2023 Body Armor Replacement Fund Grant, you have agreed to the Terms and Conditions found on the website https://www.nl.gov/oag/body-armor/. These Terms and Conditions will apply to future years of funding as well so please make sure you have a copy of them in your file.

In order to participate in the 2023 BARF Program, agencies are required to confirm that they have a written mandatory body armor wear policy for all uniformed officers engaged in patrol or field operations. Your agency is in compliance with having a policy and therefore is eligible to receive a 2023 BARF award.
