TITLE: RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND RATIFYING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP AND RIVERVIEW PAVING, INC., 859 WILLOW GROVE STREET, HACKETTSTOWN, NEW JERSEY 07840 FOR EMERGENCY ROADWAY RESURFACING ON SOUTH ESSEX AVENUE (BETWEEN CENTRAL AVENUE TO FREEWAY DRIVE EAST) IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$79,770.40.

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2024, Director of Public Works/Engineering completed a field review of the conditions of South Essex Avenue (between Central Ave to Freeway Dr. East); and

WHEREAS, based on the Director of Public Works/Engineering review, the roadway had numerous areas of noticeable asphalt pavement deterioration, widespread surface asphalt cracking, missing water and gas valve covers, catch basins in need of repair and multiple areas of utility trench repairs; and

WHEREAS, all of these conditions combine to create a safety hazard for motorist and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, this emergency roadway repairs was found to be justifiable by the Director of Public Works/Engineering; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, any contract may be negotiated or awarded for a contracting unit without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services; and

WHEREAS, the Qualified Purchasing Agent is satisfied that an emergency exists and recommends that a contract be awarded to Riverview Paving, Inc., 859 Willow Grove Street, Hackettstown, New Jersey 07842 under the MCCPC#6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township be and hereby ratifies and approves the award of a contract to Riverview Paving, Inc., 859 Willow Grove Street, Hackettstown, New Jersey 07842 for emergency roadway repairs on South Essex Avenue (between Central Ave to Freeway Dr. East) in the City of Orange Township under the emergency provisions established by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 in the total amount not to exceed \$79,770.40.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract is awarded without competitive bidding as an "Emergency Contract" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 of the Local Public Contracts Law because an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate delivery of goods or the performance of services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of this action shall be printed once a City of Orange Township designated publication as required by law within ten (10) days of its passage.

Dear Mayor Warren:

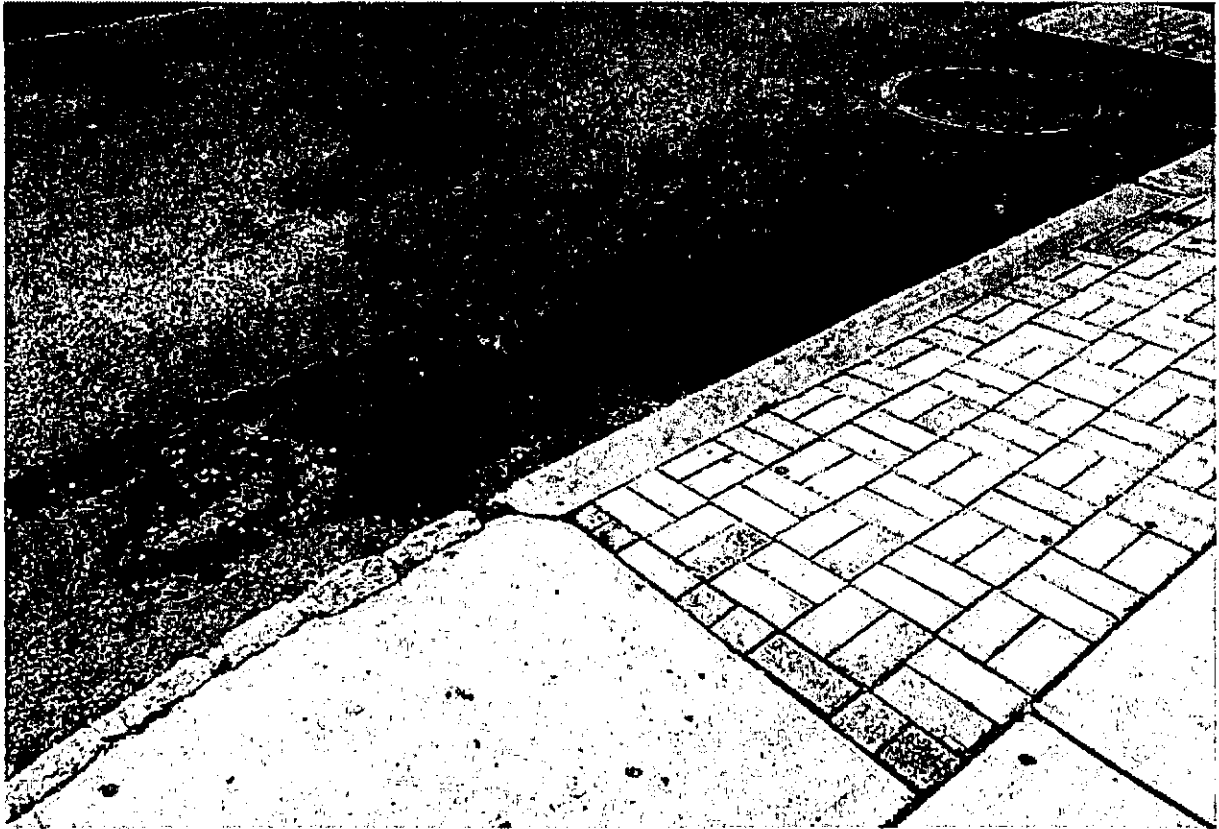
I have completed a field review of the conditions of South Essex Avenue between Central Avenue and Freeway Drive East in the City of Orange Township. Based on my review on April 22, 2024, the roadway has numerous areas of noticeable asphalt pavement deterioration, widespread surface asphalt cracking, missing water and gas valve covers, catch basins in need of repair, and multiple areas of utility trench repairs. All of these conditions combine to create a safety hazard for motorists and pedestrians. South Essex Avenue is a bona fide emergency situation affecting the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Orange Township. We also have received multiple claims for damages to vehicles. Based on the observed asphalt condition and noticeable ponding, it is likely that this roadway has drainage issues during moderate to heavy rainfall events as there was still standing water present from rainfall the week prior. Some of the existing drainage system is also non-compliant with current NJDOT standards and in need of upgrading/repairs. Attached are a few photographs documenting these conditions.

Based on my review of the conditions and the available options for improvements, we anticipate that the cost to mill and pave this section of roadway, while also upgrading the required catch basins and correcting the damaged valves, will be approximately \$82,000.00 through the Morris County Cooperative Program. It is recommended that the City of Orange Township allocate funding to improve the roadway conditions as soon as feasible to provide motorists and pedestrians an increased level of safety as well as create a long-lasting infrastructure improvement to enhance the quality of life in Orange.

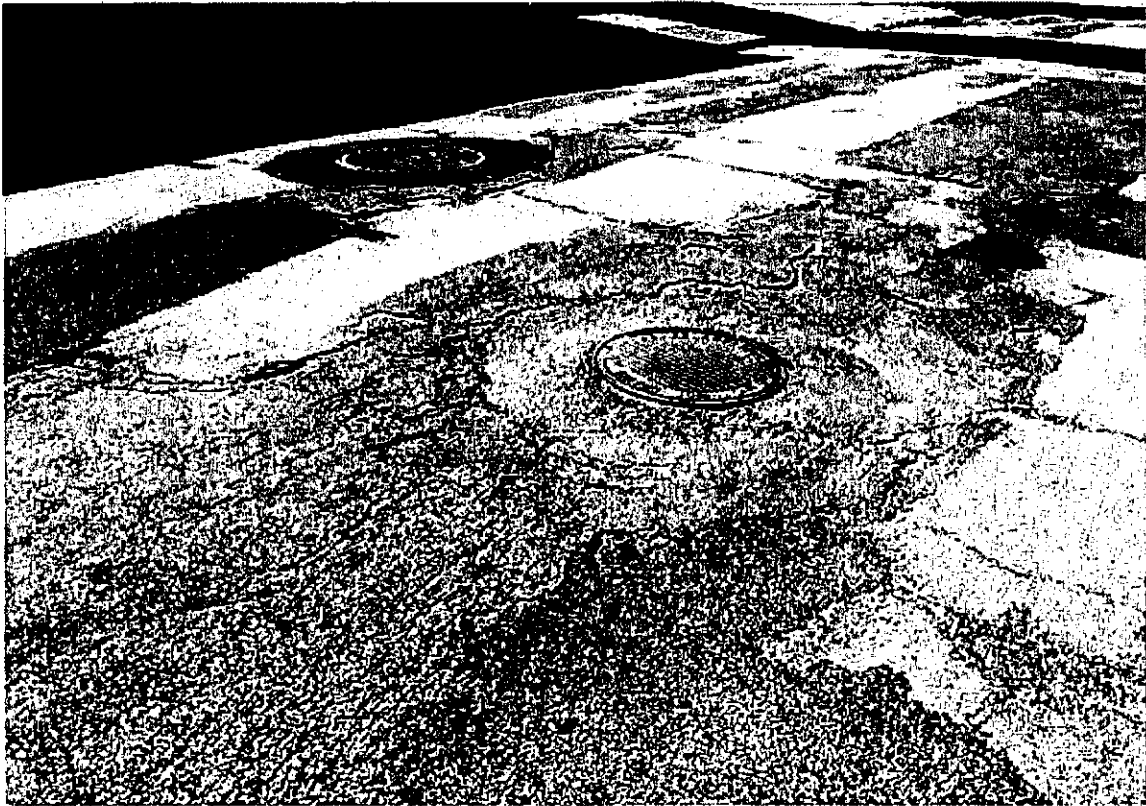

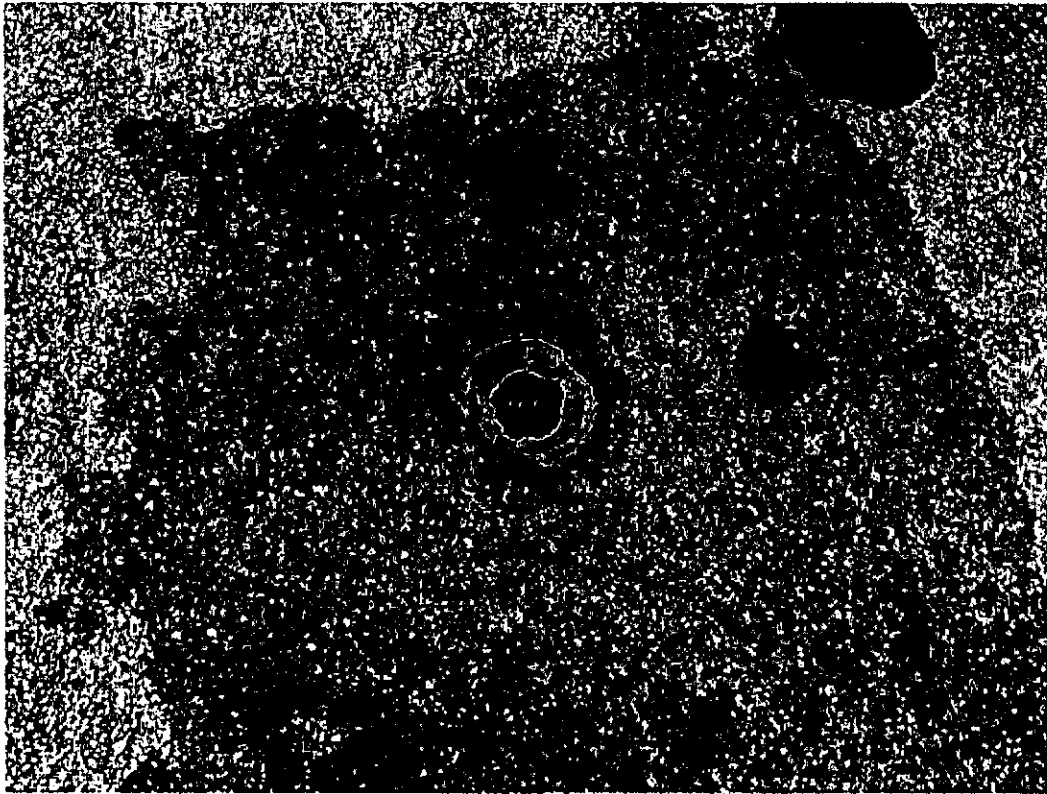


WHEREAS, the purpose of the MCCPC is to provide substantial savings on various goods and services to its members through the cooperative public bidding process; and




BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Orange Township, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows
