I. INTRODUCTION

The City of Orange Township ("City" or "Orange") is located in Essex County, New Jersey, and is home to approximately 34,000 residents across 4 wards (North, South, East and West). Organized under the Optional Municipal Charter Law—or Faulkner Act—City government is overseen by an elected Mayor and 7-member Municipal Council (1 member from each ward and 3 at-large members), with day-to-day operations delegated to the City's several departments. The Department of Planning and Economic Development ("Department") is responsible for all matters affecting physical and economic development, including enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code Act ("UCC"), N.J.S.A. 52:27D-119 et seq., through the Building and Construction Division ("Division").

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Division is seeking proposals from qualified respondents interested in providing inspection and plan review services to the City in connection with administration of the UCC Elevator Safety Subcode ("Elevator Subcode"), *N.J.A.C.* 5:23-12.1 *et seq.* The contract is for an initial term of 12 months—July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025—with an option for the City, in its sole discretion, to extend said term for an additional 12 months (i.e., through June 30, 2026).

The successful respondent ("On-site Agency") must provide the City with a staff of at least 5 full-time licensed officials/inspectors, each of whom shall independently possess the qualifications set forth below, and be expected to perform all duties assigned in a timely manner. Substitutes must be provided for any absences (e.g., sick leave, vacation leave, etc.), with notice to the Construction Official of any substitutes at least 2 weeks in advance, or as soon as possible in the event of an emergency.

A backlog of inspections will not be permitted, and the On-site Agency will be responsible for ensuring allocation of sufficient staff for all required inspections, re-inspections, plan reviews, and other duties assigned by the Construction Official in accordance with the UCC. As determined necessary by the Construction Official based on work volume, the On-Site Agency shall assign additional officials/inspectors to the City to accommodate the work volume within 2 business days of such request.

A. Official/Inspector Duties & Responsibilities

In accordance with the UCC, officials/inspectors are responsible for administering the Elevator Subcode and inspecting elevators for compliance with plans and specifications, as well as other related work as directed by the Construction Official, including without limitation:

- Inspecting new construction and renovation projects for Elevator Subcode compliance;
- Reviewing/approving plans of proposed structures for conformity with the Elevator Subcode;
- Establishing inspection schedules to ensure new elevators or those under renovation are inspected at critical stages of the construction or renovation;
- Inspecting elevator work during construction to ensure conformity with approved plans and the Elevator Subcode;
- Identifying and inspecting materials, methods and assemblies used during elevator construction or renovation for conformity with manufacturer standards and the Elevator Subcode;
- Ensuring contractors observe required standards set forth in approved plans and specifications.
- Halting work that does not meet reasonable standards of workmanship and safety, or comply with plans, specifications and/or legal requirements;





- Issuing and serving warnings, citations, notices of violations, stop work orders, or other appropriate notice for violations of the Elevator Subcode;
- Preparing violation reports, inspection reports and other correspondence;
- Presenting inspection findings to and appearing before the Construction Board of Appeals or other courts from time to time, as coordinated by the Construction Official and City Attorney; and,
- · Maintaining necessary records, reports and files.

All officials/inspectors shall be present within Orange's municipal boundaries from 8:30a until 4:30p, every Monday through Friday, excluding legal holidays observed by the City. Each official/inspector must check in at the Division's offices at the start of each day to receive inspection assignments and/or review plans, and must report back at the end of each day to return work logs and follow-up on plan reviews.

B. Minimum Qualifications for Officials/Inspectors

The On-site Agency is responsible for confirming that all officials/inspectors assigned to the City possess the following minimum qualifications:

- Valid Elevator Subcode Official license issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs ("DCA");
- Valid High-rise and Hazardous Structure Elevator Inspector license issued by DCA;
- Driver license valid in the State of New Jersey, and personal/commercial vehicle¹;
- Knowledge of office procedures for inspectors, including common forms and records;
- Knowledge of procedures for proper review and approval of permit applications;
- Knowledge of the UCC, as well as of the Elevator Subcode and its background, purpose and place in local government structure relative to other UCC enforcement programs;
- Knowledge of elevator, mechanical, and electrical maintenance inspections and design;
- Knowledge of the purpose and fundamentals of stop work orders, notices of violations and court actions;
- · Knowledge of powers and procedures available to address hazardous conditions;
- Knowledge of the situations requiring a warrant and the process of obtaining and issuing a warrant;
- Knowledge of the administrative hearing process under the UCC;
- Ability to schedule and organize work, and independently resolve problems:
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships;
- Ability to prepare/maintain clear, sound, accurate and informative case records and reports containing findings, conclusions and recommendations; and,
- Ability to learn various types of electronic and/or manual recording and information systems used by the Division (if computer training is necessary, as determined by the Construction Official, the On-site Agency shall be responsible for providing said training).

Official municipal vehicles will not be available for use by the On-site Agency or its assigned staff; however, vehicle placards will be available for use by the On-site Agency's assigned staff during inspection hours.





Officials/inspectors must also undergo criminal history record checks (conducted by the On-site Agency) and receive clearance from the Construction Official prior to being permitted to conduct inspections.

C. Term

The On-site Agency shall initially be appointed for a period of 12 months—July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025—with the City having an exclusive option to extend the appointment for 1 additional 12-month period (i.e., through June 30, 2026).

D. Fees

During the initial term and any extension thereof, the On-site Agency shall receive no more than 50% of the fee amounts set by the DCA for inspection and/or plan review under the Elevator Subcode, with the City receiving the remainder to offset associated administrative costs. Payments will be made to the On-site Agency on a monthly basis.

E. Insurance & Indemnification

During the initial term and any extension thereof, the On-site Agency shall maintain insurance coverages as follows:

- a. errors and omissions insurance with a policy limit of at least \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence;
- b. general liability/business operations insurance with a policy limit of at least \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence;
- c. workers compensation insurance with appropriate policy limits for all personnel that would be assigned to work with the City; and,
- d. automobile liability insurance with a policy limit of at least \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for each vehicle that would be used in providing services to the City.

The On-site Agency will also be required to indemnify, defend and hold the City harmless against all claims, demands, actions, suits, judgments and/or liens arising from the services performed, or material supplies and devices furnished by the On-site Agency.

F. Contract

This contract will be awarded as a "professional services agreement", as defined by the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-1 *et seq.* The On-site Agency shall be bound by the requirements and terms contained in this RFP with regard to services performed, payments, indemnification, insurance, termination, and applicable licensing provisions. The selected respondent shall enter into the City's form contract, which is available for review upon request.

After award of the Contract, any changes to the terms, including any terms contained in the Scope of Services herein, may be made, if and when necessary, by the consent of both parties, with approval of the Municipal Council. The On-site Agency shall not be permitted to assign any interest in this contract, and shall not transfer any interest in the same without prior approval by the Municipal Council.
