MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

HEALTH UPDATE

Health Officer Vincent DeFilippo stated Covid cases in New Jersey have been low and there were a few cases in the City of Orange. The Health department released a brochure with Summer Safety tips. Covid deaths in the state of New Jersey were recorded as follows: four deaths ages 30-49, 24 deaths ages 50-64, and 109 deaths for ages 65-79. There were three cases of bird flu and one case of measles in the State of New Jersey. There were a few tuberculosis cases in the City of Orange and Lantern Fly sightings has be very low.

ESSEX COUNTY LIAISON

County Liaison Reginald Bledsoe stated there was no updates from the County but he is working with Mr. Scarpelli to schedule a follow-up with the City of Orange. There has been some preliminary work that has been started in Monte Irvin Park and it will continue during the summer. Council Vice President Clifford R. Ross expressed concerns about the Monte Irvin perimeter traffic and parking during concerts in Park.
