WHEREAS, caregivers play a fundamental role in reducing hospital admissions and enhancing the continuity of care, providing billions of dollars of economic value through their unpaid work, which is often not recognized or fully appreciated; and

WHEREAS, it is essential for the City of Orange Township to acknowledge and support the caregivers within our community, offering resources, respite, and recognition for their tremendous contributions to the health and well-being of our residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township hereby proclaims the month of November as Family Caregivers Month and recognizes the invaluable contributions of all caregivers within our city; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City encourages residents, businesses, organizations, and government agencies to support and recognize family caregivers, helping to provide them with the resources, respite, and assistance they need to continue their vital roles within our community.
